Cleveland Metroparks held its official dedication of the completed Mill Creek connector trail last Wednesday, June 28, at the 150-foot pedestrian bridge over Mill Creek which connects the communities of Garfield Heights and Cuyahoga Heights to the Ohio & Erie Canal Reservation and the Towpath Trail.

This immersive trail experience along with a green retaining wall includes dozens of wildflowers for local wildlife and provides trail users with improved connections from Garfield Heights to the Towpath Trail in the Ohio & Erie Canal Reservation in Cuyahoga Heights, said Metroparks officials.

According to Cleveland Metroparks CEO Brian Zimmerman, the Metroparks worked with local property and business owners, among them Ferrotherm Corporation and Holly Sales, to make

the trail possible - a mutual investment from Cleveland Metroparks and the Garfield Heights and Cuyahoga Heights communities.

Fugitive of the Week



Witcher

The Northern Ohio Violent Fugitive Task Force is offering a reward for information which would lead to the capture of fugitive David Witcher.

Witcher is wanted by the U.S. Marshals Service and the Cleveland Police Department for homicide, according to the Northern Ohio Violent Fugitive Task Force. On May 9, David Anderson, 55, was found shot in the chest allegedly by his grandson. The homicide occurred in Anderson's home in the area of E. 105th St. and Elmarge Ave. A warrant for Witcher was issued six days after the homicide.

Witcher is a 31-year-old black male standing approximately 5'1" and weighing 170 pounds. He has brown hair and brown eyes. Witcher's last known address was in the 9700 block of Union Ave. It is believed that he is still on Cleveland's east side.

Body of teen found in creek in Metroparks' Bedford Reservation

A 15-year-old boy was reported missing Saturday evening, July 1st, around 5:30 p.m., after swimming with a group in Viaduct Park in Tinker's Creek, part of Cleveland Metroparks' Bedford Reservation. His body was later found about one mile downstream on Monday morning, according to Bedford Fire Chief David Nagy.

Nagy said the boy's body was found around 10:30 a.m. July 3rd in the creek at the bottom of a bridle trail just off the Egbert picnic area in the Cleveland Metroparks' Bedford Reservation.

A search and rescue team searched the area Saturday night until it was eventually called off due to darkness. They searched again on Sunday for several hours, but Nagy said it had to be called off due to "swift water" currents making it dangerous for the team to continue.

Husband arrested in connection to wife's murder

Garfield Heights Police Chief Robert Byrne announced last week that GHPD had arrested Monte Woodley, 45, of Bedford Heights, in the murder of his wife, Lavora Allen, the woman who was found dead in her basement in Garfield Heights on May 1st.

Allen, 38, of Orme Road, was originally reported as a missing person until police and family members found her lying at the bottom of her basement steps unresponsive. The Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner later determined she died from strangulation, according to Garfield Heights Police Chief Robert Byrne.

Woodley has been charged with murder and is being held on a \$1 million bond, according to Byrne.

State scholarship application window now open

The second application window for Ohio's EdChoice and Income-Based scholarship programs is now open for families interested in applying for a scholarship for the 2017-18 school year. The deadline to apply for these programs is July 31.

EdChoice Scholarships are available to students who are attending or are assigned to attend the state's underperforming public schools. The scholarships are worth up to \$4,650 per year for students in grades K-8 and up to \$6,000 for high school students. They are to be used toward tuition at the participating private school of the family's choice. There are 60,000 scholarships available for eligible students.

The Income-Based Scholarship Program is available for students who are entering kindergarten, first, second, third or fourth grade in the 2017-18 school year, if their family's income is at or below 200 percent of Federal Poverty Guidelines. The scholarships are worth \$4,650 and are to be used toward tuition at the participating private school of the family's choice.

Applying for one of these state-funded scholarships is just one of the many education options available in the state. School Choice Ohio is the only statewide organization that educates families on the full range of education options available for their children.

Garfield Hts. police reports

Criminal Damage

Fireworks

When police arrived, they spoke to a 24-year-old who admitted he had been setting off firecrackers. He also turned over three more packages of fireworks and was issued a summons for possession.

Also on July 2nd, around 9:50 p.m., police were called to the 13300 block of Carpenter Ave. for another fireworks complaint. The caller said the noise had been going on for about an hour. Officers spoke to a 37-year-old Maple Heights resident who admitted he had been setting off fireworks. Police saw about 10-12 more packages of fireworks that were also his. He was issued a summons for possession.

OVI

Around 3 p.m. on July 2nd, police were called to

the former Playmakers building on Granger Rd. and Transportation Blvd. for a report of a hit-skip. When police arrived they noticed a front bumper cover of a vehicle was on the corner of the building.
