## ODOT to increase fence height on Valley View bridge to improve safety

Work will include increasing the height of the existing fence on both bridges by three feet to improve safety.

## Xellia in Bedford to expand; Wal-Mart building sold

The Xellia pharmaceutical plant on Northfield Road in Bedford has announced plans to expand and hire a number of new workers, and the former Wal-Mart building on Rockside Road has been sold with plans towards development, city officials stated at the Bedford Council meeting last week.

Xellia, an international company based in Copenhagen, Denmark, moved into the former Ben Venue Laboratories location two years ago, after Ben Venue shut down in 2013, with 1100 jobs lost in the process.

In the years since, Xellia has hired about 130 workers, after receiving Food and Drug Administration approval in 2016 to begin packaging and distribution operations. An additional 75 or so new workers are expected to come on board as manufacturing is expected to begin next year, City Manager Mike Mallis stated in his report to council.

Mallis said that city officials, along with representatives from state and congressional offices and Cuyahoga County, were invited to visit and tour the facility recently. "They talked about where they've come from over the last couple of years since they've acquired the property and where they're going."

"The biggest hurdle... is that they worked with the FDA to get a modified consent decree," Mallis stated. "What

that does, it lays the groundwork to allow them to produce those lifesaving drugs again in 2018. That will happen."

"They have relocated all of their packaging and shipping operations from Chicago, Illinois, to Bedford," Mallis continued. "That's taking place now. So what that means is everything produced worldwide, in China, India, Raleigh, North Carolina, all those different locations, they come here first and then they get dispensed here."

Mayor Stan Koci, who had also visited the facility, stated of Xellia officials, "They could not impress upon us enough that they're here to stay. The good thing about Xellia is they're owned by a foundation, not a board of directors and a bunch of stockholders. So they're not worried about getting dividends even greater. They're there to do good for the people, and their big thing is pharmaceuticals, dealing with infectious diseases. And in this day and age, that's a huge thing."

## Former Wal-Mart building sold

Koci also announced at last week's meeting that the vacant Wal-Mart Supercenter in the Meadowbrook shopping center at Rockside and Northfield roads had just been sold, prompting the audience to break into applause.

Wal-Mart, which owned the building, shut down the store in early 2016 as part of restructuring efforts, causing about 350 employees to lose their jobs.

"That is some good news," Koci said, adding, "The developer is a big time developer. He's the one that brought Amazon to North Randall."

An online search of the Cuyahoga County Auditor's Office records indicated that the former Wal-Mart Supercenter property at 22209 Rockside Rd., transferred into the new owner's name, identified as Bedford

Rockside LLC & Holdings Bedford Rockside LLC, on Wednesday, Nov. 22, with a sales amount of \$2,251,547.

### 2018 budget passed

Council passed legislation to approve the city's 2018 budget in the amount of \$42.3 million, which will cover all expenses, expenditures and operations in Bedford for next year.

Councilman Donald Saunders commented, "What a lot of people don't realize is that a little community like this has a \$42 million budget, and it's because we have our own utilities. And because of those utilities, we can respond, greater and faster than a lot of other surrounding communities."

### To apply for \$200K in grants

Council also passed an ordinance to apply for a total of \$200,000 in grants from Cuyahoga County, including \$150,000 in Community Development Block Grant funding, and \$50,000 in Community Development Supplemental Grant funding. If the county approves the grants, the city may use the money for surveillance cameras in the Auto Mile area and Broadway Avenue streetscaping.

Mallis said that a public meeting was held recently to get citizen input and discuss the various projects. "We're submitting a plan for cameras and have not received the final proposal yet. We're kind of waiting on the grant till we know the exact amount to be able to extend it beyond the Auto Mile."

A recommendation had been made to use the supplemental grant funding potentially for streetscaping of the Broadway corridor of the city, Mallis said.


If the city were successful in receiving the supplemental funding, the possibility existed of renewing the grant and do another thoroughfare, perhaps Northfield Road, the following year, he stated.

Also passed by council were the following pieces of legislation: to declare 86 Willard Avenue a nuisance and condemning the property; declaring 188 Greencroft Avenue a nuisance and ordering action, including roof and porch repairs; and providing for a contract with GPD Group for engineering services for the city for 2018.

A motion to accept a recommendation of the Planning Commission for Colwood LLC of Pemberville, Ohio, owner of an apartment complex at 93 Solon Road (also known as the Wolves Cove Apartments), seeking to reconstruct a 24-bay parking garage to replace the structure that was demolished, was approved.
