## Garfield Hts. man arrested in drug raid on Burleigh

A 37-year-old Garfield Heights man was arrested last week after he tried fleeing from police during a drug raid at his home on Burleigh Avenue, according to a Garfield Heights police report.

On March 28th, around 9:45 a.m., the Cleveland Police Department (CPD) Narcotics and CPD SWAT teams were executing a search warrant for a drug

raid at a home on Burleigh Avenue in Garfield Heights, according to the report. The suspect with the warrant, the 37-year-old man, got into his vehicle and began backing out of the driveway in an attempt to flee and struck two CPD cruisers that were attempting to block him in the driveway.

The man continued backing up, ran over a neighboring front lawn, and fled onto Garfield Boulevard. Garfield Heights police gave chase and eventually arrested the man at E. 97th St. He was arrested and turned over to CPD detectives. According to the police report, the man will be charged with two counts of felonious assault.

## Shots fired on Broadway

An off-duty Cleveland police officer was inside the Metro PCS store at 5853 Broadway Ave. as a patron last Tuesday evening, around 7:45 p.m., when two males came into the store with guns in a robbery attempt, according to Cleveland police spokesperson Sgt. Jennifer Ciaccia.

The off-duty officer intervened and shots were fired outside of the store, according to Ciaccia. The suspects fled in a vehicle. No injuries were reported and no arrests have been made as of press time.

## Newburgh Hts. Council notes

The Village of Newburgh Heights Council met on Tuesday, March 20, and took the following legislative action:

- Increased the allowable height for a fence to six feet.
- Requested Planning Commission review and approval of a revised and updated village zoning map to rezone certain property on Harvard Avenue as a mixed use district.
- Approved the nomination of Officer Russ Veverka from part-time patrol to full-time patrol.
- Approved the nomination of traffic enforcement supervisor Ed Papes to full-time patrol officer.
- Purchased a Generac generator from Generator Connection at a cost not to exceed \$45,623.
- Hired Thomas Rak Landscaping for lawn, shrub and tree improvements at the Village Hall at a cost not to exceed \$7,460.

Before council began its legislative agenda, Mayor Trevor Elkins introduced Recreation Director Bill Edelburg, who presented a \$2,000 donation he received for the village's youth sports programs from American Legion Post 627. Elkins also swore in Dalton Jalovec to the Newburgh Heights Fire Department.

A moment of silence was held for Rita Petkoff, a lifelong resident of East 38th Street in Newburgh Heights. She was also a dispatcher.

# Recycle your Easter ham leftovers with these tasty recipes!

## Ham & Cheese Corn Chowder

- 2 Tbsp. butter
- 1 onion, chopped
- ½ cup carrots peeled, halved and sliced
- 3 Tbsp. flour
- 2½ cups ham, diced
- 3½ cups chicken broth
- 1½ cups frozen corn
- 2 tsp. fresh thyme leaves
- 2 small russet potatoes peeled and cut into small cubes
- 1 cup heavy cream
- 4 slices bacon cooked and crumbled
- salt and pepper to taste

Heat the butter in a large pot over medium high heat. Add the onions and carrots and cook for 4-5 minutes or until just softened.

Whisk in the flour, stirring constantly. Cook for 1 minute.

Slowly add the chicken broth, whisking constantly.

Bring to a simmer. Add the ham, corn, thyme and potatoes.

Simmer for 25 minutes or until potatoes are tender, stirring occasionally. Add the heavy cream and bacon. Cook for 5 more minutes. Serve.

## Ham & Cheese Ziti

- 1 package (16 oz.) ziti
- ¼ cup butter, cubed
- ¼ cup all-purpose flour
- 2 cups 2% milk
- 2 cups shredded white cheddar cheese
- ¼ cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 1 tsp. garlic powder
- ½ tsp. pepper
- 3 cups cubed fully cooked ham

1 package (10 oz.) frozen chopped spinach, thawed and squeezed dry

Prepare ziti according to package directions. Meanwhile, in a Dutch oven, melt butter. Stir in flour until smooth; gradually add milk. Bring to a boil; cook and stir for two minutes or until thickened. Reduce heat; add the cheeses, garlic powder and pepper. Cook and stir until cheese is melted.

Drain ziti; add to sauce mixture. Stir in ham and spinach. Transfer to a greased 13 x 9 inch baking dish. Bake, uncovered, at 375° for 20-25 minutes or until heated through.

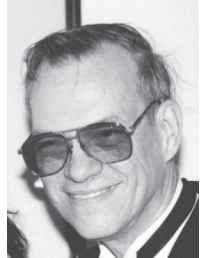

### (Continued from Page 7) Possession of GARFIELD HTS. Marijuana

#### Felonious Assault

Police were dispatched to the 13000 block of Darlington Ave. for a shots fired complaint on March 27th, around 10:15 p.m., and learned the front window of a home in the 13100 block had been struck by a bullet. The resident there told police she was sitting in the kitchen when she heard multiple gunshots, so she got on the ground, crawled to a back bedroom, and sent a text message to her brother to call police. Officers said the woman had been sitting directly in front of where the bullet came through the window. Police found seven shell casings in the street in front of the residence. The woman believes her ex-boyfriend may have been responsible but the incident is still under investigation.

On March 27th, around 2:15 p.m., police were dispatched to the area of Oak St. and Silver Rd. for a report of a suspicious vehicle parked in an empty grass lot nearby. As police approached, they saw heavy smoke inside the passenger side of the vehicle. When the driver of the car rolled down the window, heavy smoke came billowing out, as well as a strong odor of marijuana.

The driver was identified as a 19-year-old Cleveland resident. The passenger was identified as a 16-year-old (unknown residency.) Police found a small amount of marijuana in the 16-year-old's pocket. Inside the glove compartment police found a digital scale which was collected as evidence. The driver was issued a summons for possession of drug paraphernalia.

Charges pending through the Youth Bureau include possession of marijuana and drug paraphernalia.

#### Shots Fired

Police were dispatched to the area of Rexwood and E. 126th St. on March 31st, around 11:45 p.m., for a report of multiple shots fired and a black Dodge Magnum possibly being involved. Upon arrival police found 12 spent casings in different calibers directly in front of a home in the 4500 block of E. 126th St. A man sitting on the porch there was initially difficult with police, but eventually said he heard shots fired then came outside and saw his Dodge Charger had several bullet holes in it. Police searched the area and

found a Dodge Magnum parked on Rexwood and E. 139th St. The Magnum had a flat front tire and similar bullet damage to the Charger, but police were unable to confirm if it was the suspect vehicle. Police continue to investigate.

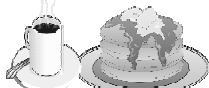
