## Cuyahoga Hts. Council votes to join Chagrin Valley Dispatch service

Cuyahoga Heights Village Council met last Wednesday, July 11, and passed legislation to join the Chagrin Valley Dispatch Council for dispatching services it has handled in-house for over 50 years. The village also provides dispatch services for Brooklyn Heights, Newburgh Heights and Valley View.

Brooklyn Heights and Valley View will also join Chagrin Valley Dispatch. The agenda for last night's meeting of Newburgh Heights Council included an emergency ordinance to join Chagrin Valley Dispatch as well. The vote was not complete as of press time.

Cuyahoga Heights Mayor Jack Bacci said the village will join Chagrin Valley in July 2019, at a new center Chagrin Valley Dispatch will operate in the Brecksville police facility. The cities of Brecksville, Independence, Seven Hills and Broadview Heights will lead in joining dispatch at the new center.

He said the cost of operating its own dispatch center in Cuyahoga Heights has been rising rapidly and necessary technology upgrades would come at a \$400,000 pricetag in the next couple years.

With the move to Chagrin Valley next year the village will save over \$300,000 within the first two years alone, Bacci said.

Chagrin Valley Dispatch is the communication center for 16 municipalities of the Chagrin Valley and greater Cleveland area.

### Other legislation passed

- The Finance Committee approved \$7,136 to replace an air conditioner in council chambers from Consolidated Heating.
- A memorial resolution was passed for Sue Revak.
- Okayed was an ordinance placing rules and restrictions on the manner by which telecommunications companies may place wireless communication facilities in the public right of way.
- A resolution was passed approving submission of the village budget estimate for fiscal year 2019.
- The Ohio Public Works Grant-Loan Agreement for the Canal Road Paving Project was authorized.
- Also okayed was a resolution accepting the Perk Company, Inc.'s bid proposal for the Harvard Avenue Full Depth Pavement Repairs Project.

## Special council meeting in Garfield Hts.

Garfield Heights Council will hold a special meeting this Monday, July 23, at 6 p.m. in the Caucus Room at the Garfield Heights Civic Center, 5407 Turney Rd., to discuss changes proposed to the City Charter by the City Charter Review Board as well as texting while driving.

In addition, the Safety Committee of Garfield Heights Council will meet on Monday, July 23, immediately following the special council meeting in the Caucus Room to discuss an incident at Bonkers bar.

## CLEVELAND HOUSE FIRES



**Fires were reported at two vacant houses on the same block of Fullerton Avenue in Slavic Village last Friday, and one vacant home on Gertrude Avenue within 24 hours of each other, according to Lt. Mike Norman, Cleveland Division of Fire Public Information Officer. The photo above shows the fiery aftermath of a home at E. 57th St. and Fullerton. No injuries were reported as the homes were vacant, but Norman said it was "an odd grouping" of fires, and they are being investigated by the Arson Unit. ## I-77 between I-490 and I-480 will be closed this weekend

Beginning Friday, July 20, at 8 p.m. through Monday, July 23, at 6 a.m. the following closures will take place on I-77 to install bridge concrete beams at Broadway Avenue and steel bridge beams erection at the SR 21 ramp:

I-77 northbound at I-480. Motorists will be detoured via I-480 west to SR 176 north to I-490 east to I-77 north.

I-77 southbound at I-490. Motorists will be detoured via I-490 west to SR 176 south to I-480 east to I-77 south.

I-480 east and westbound ramp to I-77 north. Motorists will be detoured via SR 176 north to I-490 east to I-77 north.

I-490 east and westbound ramps to I-77 south. Motorists will be detoured via I-77 north to East 30th Street to I-77 south to I-490 west to SR 176 south.

I-77 southbound at the SR 21 exit ramp. Motorists will be detoured via SR 21 south to SR 17 west to I-480 east and back onto I-77 south.

A limited amount of local access will be maintained on I-77 between I-490 and I-480 through the weekend.

## Two arrested in Maple Heights homicide; investigation continues

Maple Heights Police arrested two individuals in connection with a homicide near Stafford Park last Wednesday, according to a press release from the Maple Heights Police Department.

Officers were dispatched to Stafford Park on Mayville Avenue last Wednesday, July 11, around 8:35 p.m., after a caller said there was a large group of juveniles physically fighting and shots had been fired.

Officers from Garfield Heights, Bedford, Bedford Heights and Oakwood Village responded and found several groups of people near Milkovich Middle School on Stafford Avenue. First responders located Darnez Canion, 20, of Maple Heights, laying on the ground with a gunshot wound, according to the press release. Police gave Canion CPR until the Maple Heights Fire Department arrived. He was taken to Bedford Medical Center where he was pronounced dead, the release said.

Police said two people were taken into custody at the time and charges are pending. Maple Heights police continue to investigate.

## Independence Council meets

Independence Council met on Tuesday, July 10, and passed the following legislation:

- Accepting the consortium bid of Cargill, Inc., Deicing Technology Business Unit for purchase and delivery of rock salt for the 2018-19 snow season.
- Authorizing Youth for Christ to coordinate and direct the Campus Life Program for the 2018-19 school year.
- Accepting the proposal of Industrial Surface Sealer for services in connection with the Elmwood Courts Resurfacing Project.
- Okaying the tax budget for 2019.
- Authorizing the mayor to enter into a Relocation and Job Creation Grant Agreement with Woodside Health to relocate its operations within the city.
- Retaining the services of Hotel & Leisure Advisors, LLC in connection with the property at 5555 Brecksville Rd.
- Providing for the issuance and sale of bonds of the city

in a principal amount not to exceed \$4,000,000 to pay the property owner's portion, in anticipation of the levy and collection of special assessments, and the city's portion of the costs of sewerage system of the Rockside Woods North Sanitary Sewer Project.

- Authorizing the renewal of the contract with Qwestcom Graphics for printing and related services for the Community Spotlight.
- Purchasing labor, materials and goods for city hall improvements to the court office.
- Okaying payment to the city of Brecksville to buy dispatch and equipment and services to assure compatibility with existing equipment, software and programming for the Chagrin Valley Regional Emergency Dispatch Center.
- Purchasing five new Viking portable radios for the police department.
- Accepting the bids of Catts Construction, Inc. for the West Creek Road Improvements Project and Jefferson Drive repair work.

The Christmas in July party at the outdoor pool is scheduled for Wednesday, July 25, from noon to 3 p.m. The outdoor pool will also host the Cuyahoga Valley Swim League Championship swim meet on July 28. There will be shorter pool hours that day.

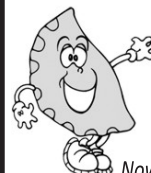

## Newburgh Heights Council notes

The Village of Newburgh Heights Council met in regular session on Tuesday, June 19, and passed the following legislation:

- To accept the bid of C.A. Agresta Construction for the resurfacing of East 55th Street in the amount of \$167,479 and authorizing change orders for the project.

- To accept the bid of Fabrizi Trucking & Paving for the sewer separation and resurfacing of Arlington Avenue with concrete and concrete curbs and gutters

in the amount of \$470,640.50 and authorizing change orders for the project.

- Councilman Steve Moran motioned for approval of the purchase of a sign and its installation on East 49th Street at Fleet Avenue for Krusoe Sign at a cost not to exceed \$16,400. Motion passed.

- Councilman Brian Schaffran nominated Gigi Traore to fill the vacancy on council caused by the death of Robert Schippling. Moran nominated William

Dunman. After a 3-1 vote, Traore was appointed the fifth member of council.

- Moran motioned for approval of the appointment of Cathleen Nagorski as delegate and Trevor Elkins as alternate to the Regional Council of Governments of the Regional Income Tax Agency. Motion passed.

- A motion was also passed to buy two new Taser units for the police department from Axon Enterprise at a cost not to exceed \$4,215.

Service Director Joe Milano reported that the salt storage shed is under construction. Because it is being built on the site of a former home, the foundation contractor was concerned about settling issues, but adjusted the project to provide more stability. Milano said the protective structure was ordered.

### Special meeting

Newburgh Heights Council met in special session on Wednesday, June 20, and adopted a resolution approving the alternative tax budget for the fiscal Year 2019.

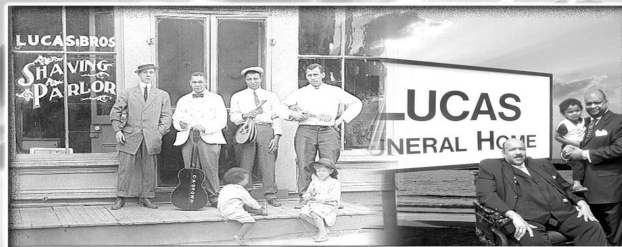

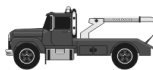

#### Felonious Assault

Officers said the male immediately became "short" with officers and had a poor attitude.

The suspect was recognized from past incidents on security camera surveillance. Police arrested the 30-year-old and charged him with breaking and entering, theft and criminal damaging.

## Valley View to also join Chagrin Valley Dispatch

At last Tuesday's Valley View Council meeting, council passed legislation authorizing the mayor to enter into an agreement with the Chagrin Valley Dispatch Center (CVD) New Member Participation Agreement to provide dispatch services from the CVD's Regional Communication Center, slated to be operating by the end of 2018 in Brecksville.

Also among legislation passed was an ordinance accepting a bid for the Valley View Pre-disaster Mitigation Competitive Program demolition project for 8579 Murray Rd.

The Village was reviewing alternate methods of administering the residential grass cutting program, but the ordinances on the agenda were defeated by council. The proposal was to serve Zone A (Fosdick Road, Murray Road, Frances Drive, Charles Drive and Gleeson Drive); Zone B (Strathmore Subdivision); and Zone C (up to one acre maximum on Alexander Road, Indian Mound Road, Canal Road, Tinkers Creek Road, Hathaway Road, Schreiber Road, Donald Avenue, Stone Road, Beverle Hill Road and Sweet Valley Drive).

### Mayor's Report

Mayor Jerry Piasecki said that on July 29th there will be a grand re-opening of the Sherwood Forest Event Center on Tinkers Creek Road.
