Bulldogs players kick off G.H. council meeting

Garfield Heights High School Bulldogs varsity football coach Lance Reisland kicked off the Monday night meeting of council by introducing some of the players on his undefeated team.

"This team is the talk of the town," Mayor Vic Collova said. "They've already clinched a playoff position for only the fourth time in school history," he said.

The Bulldogs, now 9-0, will finish the regular season at home Friday playing Normandy (3-6) at 7 p.m.

Collova noted that if the Bulldogs go 10-0 for a perfect season, it will be the first time in 41 years of play.

The mayor also noted that residents should be aware that the sewer department will be dye testing the lines in the coming days.

Warnings issued

Service Director Tim McLaughlin reported that 200 warnings had been issued to residents who failed to bring their trash cans from the curb within 12 hours after pickup. He said those with warnings will be issued tickets for the next violation. Violators can be fined up to \$150 per ticket.

Economic Development Director Noreen Kuban announced that Neighborhood Housing Services of Greater Cleveland is partnering with the city to offer free "Help for Homeowners" with property tax concerns. NHS staff will be available to meet with residents from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m., Wednesday, Nov. 14, at the Civic Center. For information or to register call Stephanie at 216-205-4468.

Legislation

The following was among legislation passed by council Monday night:

- An emergency ordinance authorizing the mayor to enter into an agreement with OHM Advisors to provide engineering, bidding and construction tasks for the Broadway Paving Project encompassing the entire stretch of Broadway Avenue within the city of Garfield Heights.

This project is estimated to cost \$1,770,000 with the federal share being 80 percent or \$1,416,000. The city will provide all additional costs.

- A resolution authorizing the mayor to apply for the 2018 Assistance to Firefighters Grant through the Department of Homeland Security.

The city would like to use the grant funding to purchase two sets of extrication equipment (Jaws of Life), new fire hose, and an exhaust removal system.

Through the AFG program, the city can be awarded up to 90 percent of the total cost of the desired equipment.

- A resolution commemorating October as National Breast Cancer Awareness Month.

The next regular council meeting will be held on Tuesday, Nov. 13.

Newburgh Heights Council approves several purchases

The Village of Newburgh Heights Council met in regular session on Tuesday, Oct. 2, and approved the purchase of 4052 E. 44 St. from Citibank N.A. at a cost of \$81,000.

Also okayed was a \$1,476.73 increase to the amount previously authorized for Engine 54 tire replacement project; \$13,000 for Allegra Construction to remove an extraneous entrance to the BP gas station at the corner of Harvard and E. 49th St.; and an additional \$2,500 for the village's website redesign by WRIS Web Services.

Legislation

An ordinance establishing the rate of pay for the village's recreation director and repealing any conflicting pay provision was passed.

Council authorized the mayor to offer for sale to other Ohio municipal corporations a Building Department vehicle, and if no sale is completed, to place it up for sale on the Govdeals auction website.

A motion passed to accept grant funds from the Ohio Department of Public Safety in the amount of \$3,575 to purchase EMS training and equipment.

Council passed a resolution to apply to the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency for grant funding through the Transportation for Livable Communities program.

Reports

Mayor Trevor Elkins announced that the village was awarded a \$290,000 grant for the E. 42nd St. sewer separation project, and also applied for funding from Small Governments and the Cleveland Division of Water.

"If we can put the funding together, the project calls for sewer lines, new water lines and a new street on E. 42nd from Alpha Avenue southbound to Harvard Avenue," Elkins said.

He said the entrance sign to the village at Fleet/Washington Park is underway with the foundation finished and the sign itself in progress.

Councilwoman Dorene Kray said fall events at Kathy Edwards Park have been planned for Sunday, Oct. 28: Family Fall Fest from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m., and Chili Cookoff from 3 to 5 p.m.

Police Chief John Majoy noted that NHPD has confiscated 25 guns since March. "Thank you to the officers for their diligence to help keep residents safe," he said.

Fire Chief Brian Higginbotham said construction/demolition will begin in earnest at the old RTA garage. Plans call for the removal of underground storage tanks and will be closely supervised, he said.
