Newburgh Heights seeks to create Student Loan Assistance Program

At the regular session of Newburgh Heights Village Council on Tuesday, November 6, Mayor Trevor Elkins, in a news release, said he would be introducing legislation on first reading to provide student loan debt relief to those buying homes in Newburgh Heights.

Ordinance 2018-62 outlines incentives and terms by which the village would fund the program to be administered by the Newburgh Heights Community Improvement Corporation. It is scheduled for second reading at the November 20th meeting and then scheduled for adoption on third reading at the December 4th meeting.

Elkins said the program is designed to stabilize, grow and develop the population of Newburgh Heights, tax base and housing stock by encouraging college and nursing graduates to purchase a home in the village by providing an incentive

of the lesser of half the homebuyer's student loan debt total or \$50,000.

Upon residency of 10 years, the incentive is vested at 80 percent and upon residency of 15 years, it is vested at 100 percent. It is believed to be the first of its type in Ohio and perhaps the nation, Elkins said.

"I believe this proposal has the support of council and I anticipate its adoption," the mayor commented. (Yesterday's meeting had not yet taken place as of press time.)

According to the proposed legislation, "The Village wishes to infuse young professionals into its population, lessen college gradu-

ates' student loan burden, and improve its local economy by providing a student loan assistance program as an incentive to young college graduates and professionals to live in and own a home in the village."

It continues, "There are numerous infill lots located throughout the village due to the demolition of blighted and/or nuisance properties, and the infusion of young professionals and college graduates will create a market for the construction of new housing on these infill lots, which, otherwise, would likely remain vacant and unproductive."

Local teams advance in playoffs

The Garfield Heights High School varsity football team made history last week when they defeated Warren G. Harding, 42-25. The win marks the first time the Bulldogs have had an 11-0 season and the first time the team has won a playoff game in the school's history.

"I am so proud of my kids and my staff," said Head Coach Lance Reiland.

The Bulldogs advance to the Division II regional semifinal game against Akron Archbishop Hoban this Friday, Nov. 9, at 7 p.m. at Hudson Memorial Stadium. Archbishop Hoban is also an 11-0 team and is ranked number one in the state.

The Maple Heights High varsity football team also remains undefeated after beating Youngstown Boardman last week, 42-12. The Mustangs will play Painesville Riverside High School (9-2) on Friday, Nov. 9, at 7 p.m. at Mayfield Wildcat Stadium.

The Cuyahoga Heights High varsity football team (9-2) advanced to the Division VII semifinal game after defeating Tuscarawas last week, 42-13. The Redskins will face East Canton (8-3) at Hudson Memorial Stadium on Saturday, Nov. 10, at 7 p.m.

Coincidentally, in their wins last week, the Bulldogs, Mustangs and Redskins all scored 42 points against their opponents.

Suspect shot, killed during alleged S.V. home invasion

Cleveland police are investigating last week's felonious assault shooting that left one man dead and a woman injured on East 78th St. in Slavic Village, according to Detective Reginald Lanton with CPD.

Police were dispatched to a home in the 3800 block of East 78th St. last Tuesday, Oct. 30, around 8 p.m., and found a 25-year-old male outside the home who had multiple gunshot wounds. Police and EMS provided treatment to him but he died on scene.

A 37-year-old woman at the scene suffered a gunshot wound to the stomach and was taken to an area hospital for treatment, according to Lanton.

Officers learned that the 25-year-old male and another unknown suspect went into the East 78th St. home with weapons drawn and began firing. One of the occupants of the home fired back, hitting the 25-year-old suspect. He retreated outside where police and EMS found him, according to Lanton.

Police said the 37-year-old woman was hit during the exchange of gunfire. A second suspect fled the area before police arrived and it is unknown if he was injured.

There were three children in the house at the time of the incident who were not injured, according to Lanton. Detectives continue to investigate.

From the courtroom...



Re'Jon Luttrell, 19, was sentenced to seven years in prison by Cuyahoga County Court Judge Nancy Fuerst last week, according to court records.

Luttrell pleaded guilty to two counts of felonious assault and one count of having weapons while under disability stemming from an incident in Garfield Heights

during the early morning hours of January 1st, 2018. Police said Luttrell got into an argument with two 18-year-old girls at an apartment on East 126th Street in Garfield Heights and shot them both in the leg.

Luttrell was featured as the Northern Ohio Violent Fugitive Task Force "Fugitive of the Week" in May and he was arrested in Warrensville Heights the next day. He was wanted for attempted murder, but those charges had been dropped prior to sentencing, according to court records.


Court records state Luttrell must have no contact with the victims and post release control is part of the prison sentence for three years.

Indy awarded grants

Independence Mayor Anthony Togliatti, in his Administrative Report recently, announced that the Ohio attorney general's office notified Independence that it has been awarded a \$23,944.50 grant which will cover 75 percent of the cost to replace officers' body armor in the Police Department.

This grant was the result of a collaborative effort between Chief Michael Kilbane, Purchasing Coordinator Dennis Zdolshek and Finance Director John Veres, Togliatti said. The grant was offered by the attorney general along with the Ohio Bureau of Workers Compensation.

Togliatti also announced that the Recreation Department is the conditional recipient of a \$35,000 NatureWorks grant from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources. NatureWorks is a state funded grant program that provides up to 75 percent of project cost assistance to Ohio municipalities, counties, townships, joint recreation districts, park districts and conservancy districts for acquisition or development of public outdoor recreation areas.

He said following an approval at the next meeting of the State of Ohio Controlling Board, the awarded funds will be incorporated in Phase 2 of the city's Liberty Playground renovations scheduled for spring 2019, which will encompass a new play structure for children ages 2-5 as well as three pieces of adaptive play equipment for children with accessibility needs.

"I would like to thank Eric Sarley of the Recreation Department as well as Director Tom Walchanowicz for their dedicated effort in putting this application together," the mayor said.
