Police from nearly 20 different departments took the children shopping at Target in Northfield where they were each given \$150 to spend. The money was tax free, courtesy of the George Murray Foundation.

"This was the 23rd year of Shop with a Cop," said Nick DiMarco, past president of the Fraternal Order of Police. "I started this in 1996 when I was president of a local lodge, and was hoping to take about 30 kids when I started. We took 45 kids that year and it's kept growing ever since."

After shopping, the kids, their families and police officers enjoyed a pizza party at Garfield Heights High School.

Garfield Hts. police investigating homicide of Darlington Ave. man

Garfield Heights police are investigating the recent death of 27-year-old Meshach Cornwall.

He was found with multiple gunshot wounds at his home on Darlington Avenue in Garfield Heights Monday morning and authorities are investigating his death as a homicide,

according to police.

GHPD was dispatched to the home on December 17th, around 11:40 a.m., when his mother called and said she found him at the bottom of the basement stairs unresponsive and bleeding. Police found he had been shot in his torso and there were multiple

bullet holes in the basement hallway, according to a police report.

Police do not have any suspects in custody at this time. A gold 2009 Honda Accord (Ohio license plate FRL 4579) was stolen from the home and police are currently looking for the

vehicle.

An autopsy will be performed to determine the official cause of death.


Anyone with information about the stolen vehicle is urged to immediately contact their local law enforcement agency as the occu-

Holiday trash pickup schedules

The following communities remind residents of rubbish pick up schedules during the weeks of the Christmas and New Year holidays. Those with questions should contact their local service department.

Bedford rubbish pick up will be one day late the weeks of December 24th and December 31st.

In **Cuyahoga Heights**, rubbish will be collected on Wednesday, Dec. 26, and special pick up will be offered on December 27th. Trash will be collected on New Year's Eve, and special pick up will be offered on Wednesday, Jan. 2.

Garfield Heights rubbish pick up will be one day late the weeks of Christmas and New Year's for Tuesday to Friday collections.

In **Independence**, rubbish and recycling will be picked up on Mondays, Dec. 24 and Dec. 31. For those with Tuesday collec-

tions, rubbish and recycling will be picked up on Wednesdays, Dec. 26 and Jan. 2.

Maple Heights rubbish pick up will be delayed one day on Christmas Day and New Year's Day.

There will be no change to the rubbish pick up schedule in **Newburgh Heights** during the weeks of Christmas and the New Year holiday, as trash pick up is on Mondays in the Village.

There will be a one day delay in rubbish collection in **Slavic Village** beginning Tuesday, Dec. 25, in observance of Christmas and one day delay beginning Tuesday, Jan. 1, in observance of New Year's Day.

During the week's of Christmas and the New Year in **Valley View**, rubbish will be picked up on Wednesday and Thursday each week, and recycling will be picked up as normal on Fridays. There will be no yard waste pick up during the holiday weeks.

Trail section now closed

The Ohio & Erie Canal Towpath Trail between Deep Lock Quarry and Hunt House is closed while a contractor installs a steel pedestrian bridge. The closure will likely continue through late winter or early spring.

The temporary closure is necessary for public safety, said Cuyahoga Valley National Park officials. There will be no detour available. Please respect the closure.

The temporary detour that has been available since mid-summer will not be open during this phase.

Baked Kruszki or Listy

- 2 cups flour
- 2 sticks oleo
- ½ cup sour cream
- 2 egg yolks
- 1 tsp. vanilla

Blend together flour and oleo as for pie dough. Mix together sour cream, egg yolks and vanilla. Mix sour cream mixture with flour mixture. Knead on floured board until smooth. Make roll and wrap in waxed paper. Keep in refrigerator overnight. Cut roll into four pieces. Work with one piece at a time. Keep the rest in the refrigerator. Roll thin and cut into diamond shapes. Slit in center and pull corner through or just cut. Bake at 350° for 8-9 minutes or until golden brown on an ungreased cookie sheet. Dust with powdered sugar after baking.

Red Christmas Cake with White Chocolate Glaze

- 2 sticks unsalted butter
- 3 cups sugar
- 4 large eggs, room temp.
- 3 cups unbleached flour
- ¼ tsp. baking soda
- 1 can cherry pie filling
- 1 Tbsp. cherry extract
- 1½ (1 oz.) bottles red food coloring

GLAZE:

- 10 oz. super white chocolate coating (sold in bakery supply stores in 1-lb. bags)
- 3 Tbsp. Crisco

For cake: Preheat oven to 325° and generously spray a bundt pan with cooking spray for baking.

Put pie filling in the food processor, pulse 5 times. In mixer set on medium speed, beat the butter and sugar for two minutes. Add in the eggs, one at a time, then add the flour and baking soda. Set mixer speed to low and blend in the rest of the ingredients. Transfer batter to the prepared pan. Bake for 1 hour and 15 minutes.

For glaze: Preheat oven to 200°. Layer white chocolate and Crisco in a 4-cup Pyrex pitcher. When oven reaches 200°, turn heat off and place pitcher in oven for 15 minutes. Remove pitcher from oven and stir until completely smooth. Drizzle over cake, letting it drip down the sides.

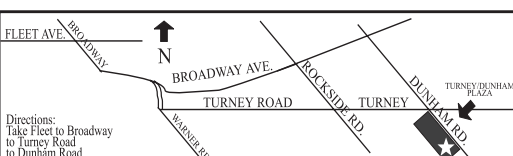

In a short meeting held last Wednesday, Dec. 12, Cuyahoga Heights Council passed the following legislation:

- Agreement to acquire the rear portion of property at 4619 E. 49 St. for \$5,000 for the Nicky Boulevard Project.

• Memorial resolution for longtime resident Donna Pellini, who passed away this month.

Council also okayed individual motions to hire Jesse James and Cory Pucci for two labor positions in the service department and Wendy Heinzman as full-time administrative assistant in the Village Hall.

A motion was also passed to hire Jason Deal to the part-time position of recreation manager.




Local Santa still bringing joy at Christmas

Bob Halan, a long-time resident of Maple Heights, has been portraying Santa Claus for 63 years. He has volunteered at churches, schools, nursing homes and hospitals, and has even been hired by the Cleveland Cavaliers to spread Christmas joy!

He said he bought his first Santa suit and a mask at Kresge's, a dime store, over 60 years ago. After that his first wife made him a suit, and now he has one that was tailor-made for him. He designed it and all his

Santa gear himself. He said he has seen Santa suits in stores for upwards of \$1500, but his is superior.

Halan said he started volunteering as Santa because of children. He wanted them to believe in Santa Claus and to behave, telling them "Santa's watching!" Despite his many hardships in life, he still finds it in his heart to bring joy to so many.

Halan has been on TV, in newspapers and magazines and on the radio. He said he has been called the "preaching Santa" because he always tells children he does not believe in violence.

"When children ask for toy guns or knives, I tell them I do not like violence. I only want peace on earth," said Halan.

He also wishes the children good health, teaches them the "Golden Rule,"

and wants all children to respect themselves and others. "That is what I try to instill and what I live my life by."

Halan said he used to volunteer as Santa at a local Kmart store and has done many breakfasts with Santa, bowling with Santa, and for 40 years would go door-to-door delivering gifts to children in Maple Heights on Christmas Eve. He said for a long time no one knew it was him portraying Santa Claus.

The question he is most asked by children is how he gets up and down the chimney, and his response is simply, "It's magic!"

He has never accepted gifts, "only milk and cookies - chocolate chip are Santa's favorite," he says with a twinkle in his eyes. Halan says being Santa to him means never accepting payment of any kind for his volunteer work. "I'm Santa from the heart, not my pocket," he said.

Halan has many stories about his time as Santa Claus. In one of his stories, he talked about giving hope to a young boy.

"I was at an event for the Cub Scouts and a young boy said, 'Santa, I want my grandpa to come home for Christmas.' I asked him where his grandpa was and he told me he was in the hospital. So the next day I went to the hospital dressed as Santa and prayed with the grandfather and told him his grandson wanted him home. I wish I could

have known if Grandpa made it home that Christmas."

In another story, a little faith was restored to Santa himself.

"A family brought their young daughter in who did not speak or hear to see me. I told her that if she came back next year and could talk with Santa, I would give her my entire basket of candy. The following year, she came back, and she talked with me. It brought tears to my eyes. I reached down and handed her my whole basket. When she protested, I told her Santa never goes back on his word. That touched my heart so deeply," he said.

Santa also laughed when remembering children who would sit on his lap with long lists of toys they wanted, or even a toy catalog, and would point out exactly what they wanted. Other children would ask for beds, or for loved ones to come back home, and he said those stories were the saddest.

Recently, Halan has volunteered at the St. Michael bingo hall on Wallings Road in Broadview Heights. He also volunteers there during Christmas in July.

"I've had over 700,000 children - and adults - on my lap!" said Halan, who said his knees are slowing him down. He has tried to get others to take over this beloved role, but said he will most likely "be Santa until I die."

He wishes everyone good health, peace and a Merry Christmas!

Youth art project unveiled for Opportunity Corridor

The Opportunity Corridor Section 3 Project (OC3) has announced a collaboration with the Boys & Girls Clubs of Cleveland members on the OC3 Community Youth Art Project.

This initiative, spearheaded by the Kokosing Construction Company Design-Build Team, provides an opportunity for the club's young people to get involved with the project by contributing their time and talents to create personalized murals that will be visible in the community.



OC3 is the third and final section of the new Opportunity Corridor located within the city of Cleveland. The Opportunity Corridor is a planned boulevard that will run from East 55th Street at Interstate 490 to East 105th Street in University Circle.

The project is being managed by the Ohio Department of Transportation District 12, the city of Cleveland and Kokosing Construction Company, Inc. The three-mile boulevard will provide improved access to and through the communities of Slavic Village, Central, Kinsman, Buckeye-Shaker and Fairfax.

Boys & Girls Clubs of Cleveland kids Monday put the final touches on 20 4-foot by 4-foot panels they designed and painted for display in front of demolition sites along OC3. Kids from five different clubs worked on the project. Their artwork will now be coated with an anti-graffiti material, mounted on fencing in front of demolition sites along the corridor and moved as construction continues.

More than 85 percent of Boys & Girls Clubs of Cleveland members live at or below the poverty line. Their families hope the Opportunity Corridor, when completed, will bring new jobs to a struggling East Side neighborhood and generally boost economic development.



Independence mine to cease operations; council passes TIF agreement for Topgolf

At last week's Independence Council meeting, an ordinance was approved relating to the closing of the DiGeronimo Aggregates mine at the bottom of Stone Road, which will cease mining operations as of January 1, 2019.

The mine, formerly known as Haydite, is one of the largest open strip mines in Ohio and currently operates with 21 employees, Mayor Anthony Togliatti informed residents in his December 14th online Administrative Update.

"Our hearts and best wishes go out to those 21 people, while at the same time some long-standing resident concerns will finally be resolved," Togliatti said.

"Since obtaining the mine, DiGeronimo Aggregates has continually worked with us over the years to try and mitigate some of those issues," Togliatti continued. "Their cooperation and commitment to assist us has been much appreciated."

He said the ordinance passed last week accepts the plan to return the property to its natural state which will then be donated to the Cuyahoga Valley National Park.

An ordinance was also passed related to the Topgolf entertainment complex planned in the city. The legislation declares the public improvements to the parcel of property where Topgolf will be located to be for a "public purpose," described the public improvements on the parcel and requires the owners to make service payments in lieu of taxes and establishes the Topgolf Municipal Public Improvement Tax Increment Equivalent Fund for the deposit of service payments.

In his report to council, Mayor Togliatti said the ordinance, better known as Topgolf TIF (tax increment financing), is a partnership agreement between the city

of Independence and the Independence School District.

"Tonight council will act on a proposal that will keep our school district financially whole throughout the 30 years of the TIF agreement and will provide the schools with \$673,500 of additional revenue over that 30-year period," the mayor continued. "This is \$673,500 of revenue above and beyond what the schools would have received if the city did not execute a TIF agreement on this parcel of land."

Other legislation passed at last week's meeting included:

- Accepting the proposal of Medical Mutual for group health insurance and prescription drug coverage at no increase from the previous year and Standard Insurance Company for group dental and vision insurance at a nominal increase for all eligible city employees.

- Accepting the proposal of Cummins Sales and Service for emergency repairs to the fire department's 2014 E-One engine.

- Amending an ordinance relating to provisions of emergency medical services; fees and charges.

- Authorizing the disposal of surplus and unneeded city vehicles, office furniture, equipment and miscellaneous property through Govdeals online auction service.

- Retaining Mannik & Smith Group, Inc. to provide right-of-way utility inspection services.

- Accepting the bid of Akron Tractor Equipment for the purchase and delivery of a Kubota RTV X1100 utility vehicle and related equipment for the recreation department at a cost of \$23,065.

- Accepting the proposal of Comfort Systems USA for purchase and installation of a new air handling unit and a new condensing unit for the fire department.

- Entering into an agreement with the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees Local 2339 and Ohio Council 8 (AFSCME).

Human Resource Director Letitia Linker said the city went through the collective bargaining process with the AFSCME employees. The wage settlement is 2 percent, 2½ percent and 3 percent in a three-year period covering 2019 through 2021.

On December 10th, around 11 p.m., police were dispatched to the 13700 block of S. Parkway for a report of shots fired. The caller said he heard about four gunshots then saw a white, 4-door vehicle with a sunroof leave the area towards E. 131st St.

As police arrived at the scene and began searching for evidence they found four spent casings in front of a home in the 13600 block of S. Parkway - two Blazer 9mm Luger casings and two Blazer 45 caliber casings. Police found three bullet holes through windows in the front of the home. No damage was found from a fourth shot. There were four people inside the home at the time of the shooting but no injuries were reported. Police noted that one of the people inside the home was not very

cooperative with officers regarding who might have shot her house.
