## Cuyahoga County Board of Revision taking 2018 valuation complaints

Following the 2018 sexennial reappraisal and concerns from property owners that their property values have risen, Cuyahoga County residents may now submit valuation complaints to the Board of Revision (BOR).

Taxpayers have until April 1, 2019 to file a complaint.

"Filing a complaint with the Board of Revision is your opportunity to sit down with the hearing board and present your case as to why your tax year 2018 property value is too high," said Shelley Davis, administrator, Cuyahoga County Board of Revision.

There are several different ways to file a complaint. You can:

1. E-File online, through email. This is the most efficient method. Online filing does not require notarization.
2. Print a form and mail it in. Paper copies need to be signed and notarized.
3. Visit the BOR office at 2079 East 9th St., Cleveland, and fill out a complaint in person. There is usually a notary on site.

The Board of Revision will set a hearing date that homeowners are encouraged to attend, as hearing officers often have questions regarding the details of the case.

Timing of a scheduled hearing will depend on the complexity of a case, number of parties involved in the case and if the BOR is required to make notice to a Board of Education. Taxpayers willing to waive their 10-day hearing notice usually can be scheduled in-between vacancies. You can contact the BOR by emailing to: [borinfo@cuyahogacounty.us](mailto:borinfo@cuyahogacounty.us) or call 216-443-7195 to check on the status of your hearing.

Taxpayers are encouraged to submit evidence supporting their case.

The Board of Revision website provides some examples of the kind of evidence you can submit. Please note that all your evidence material must be labeled with the parcel number.

## Fugitive of the Week

The Northern Ohio Violent Fugitive Task Force is offering a reward for information which would lead to the capture of fugitive Jerome Rivers. Rivers, also known as "Pony Boy," is wanted by the United States Marshals Service and the Cleveland Division of Police for aggravated murder, aggravated burglary and felonious assault.

On October 30, 2018, Rivers was allegedly involved in a home invasion near the 3800 block of East 78th Street in Slavic Village where a co-defendant was shot and killed and a woman was injured.

Rivers, 29, is a black male, standing approximately 5'11" and weighing 205 pounds. His last known address is the 10300 block of Eliot Avenue in Cleveland. Rivers should be considered armed and dangerous.

## M.H. Council renews property escrow waiver for 2019

In an effort to continue to encourage individuals to purchase and renovate properties in Maple Heights, city council again passed an ordinance to waive the 100 percent escrow requirement to correct violations resulting from point of sale inspections, at its first meeting of the year last week.

The city wants to keep offering the Owner Occupied Homeowner Incentive Program to people who purchase residential properties from January 2nd through December 31st, 2019. This is a continuation of a program first implemented in 2017.

"So long as the purchaser actually occupies such residential property," the owner is eligible to receive the escrow waiver from Mayor Annette Blackwell, according to the legislation.

Participants in this program will be required to sign an affidavit attesting that the purchaser will live in the property as their primary residence for two years, starting on the issuance of an occupancy permit, the ordinance states.

## Maple Heights to hold public reception for local heroes

A public reception for two local Good Samaritans will be held on Wednesday, Jan. 16, at 5:30 p.m. at the Maple Heights Senior Center, 15901 Libby Rd.

Honored will be cousins Rayfield Hallman and Steven William Wood who stopped while driving down Raymond Avenue in Maple Heights last month when they saw an unconscious woman on the ground in the doorway of her home and her toddler asleep on her chest on a bitterly cold day. They called police and stayed with the mother and child until help arrived.

"The mayor, police chief, City Council President Ron Jackson, the administration and the entire community of Maple Heights will recognize these kind, caring and special heroes," a press release from the city stated.

## Master Plan to be updated

Also passed at last week's meeting was an ordinance to adopt the 2018 City of Maple Heights Master Plan, as the last update occurred in 1999.

In 2017, the city received a grant from the Cuyahoga County Department of Development to update the Master Plan. The county started work on the city's Master Plan in the fall of 2017, including gathering input from city officials, residents, business owners and other stakeholders; accumulating and analyzing data about current conditions; developing the city's vision for the future and goals and ways to reach that vision; and preparing the final Master Plan document.

The county presented the Master Plan to a joint meeting of council and the Planning and Zoning Commission on October 23, 2018. With council's decision to adopt the new Master Plan, the 1999 plan is replaced, according to the legislation.

## Consolo to continue as law director

Frank Consolo, who has served as the city's law director since his appointment by Blackwell in September 2016, will continue in his post through December 31, 2019, according to a resolution passed by council.

Consolo's reappointment and contract renewal thereafter will be for terms of two years, according to the legislation, subject to approval by council.

# Community police reports

## CLEVELAND

### Homicide

Cleveland police are investigating the death of a 57-year-old male who was shot on January 6th. Police said they initially responded to the 8500 block of Force Ave. around 6:55 p.m. regarding a pedestrian who had been hit by a car. He had been receiving medical treatment at the scene when it was discovered he had been shot twice in the abdomen. He was taken to a local hospital where he died.

Police later learned that shots were heard before witnesses saw the man being run over by a small, newer model SUV driven by an unknown female. Homicide detectives continue to investigate.

### Felonious Assault Shooting

Police are investigating what led to a 14-year-old being the victim of a gunshot graze to the leg in the 7800 block of Spafford Rd. on January 1st, around 8 p.m. No further information was available as of press time.

## GARFIELD HEIGHTS

### Criminal Damage

•A woman told police her car was damaged overnight between December 31st and January 1st in the 12200 block of Valley Lane Dr. Police found three bullet holes in the car doors and both rear passenger windows

shattered. The woman said she did hear multiple bouts of gunfire throughout the night.

•A man told police his car was damaged overnight between December 31st and January 1st while parked in a parking lot in the 12100 block of Valley Lane Dr. A bullet fired into the back of his vehicle damaged the hatch and went through the back seat. A second bullet was fired through the back window and went through the windshield.

•On January 2nd, around 8:25 p.m., a man told police he found five bullet holes in his storage building in the 13900 block of Broadway Ave. Police said two of the bullets appeared to go all the way through the building. The man said the damage may have occurred on New Year's Eve but knew of no possible suspects.

### Weapon Offense

•A resident of the 4500 block of E. 104th St. said the front double-pane window of her apartment was damaged by gunfire between December 31st and January 1st. Police found a round on the woman's living room floor in front of the television. There were no suspects.

•A resident of the 12100 block of Valley Lane Dr. said that around midnight between December 31st and January 1st she heard either gunshots or fireworks going off in the area. She then heard something hit her front window, her blinds and then her wall. Police could not find a bullet inside the home but saw the small hole in the woman's window screen and window blind.

•A resident of the 4800 block of E. 90th St. told police there had been a large party across the street from her on January 1st, and around 2:30 a.m., about 10 people came outside. She said she saw a man in the group point a handgun in the grass in the front yard and fire several shots. A woman who lives next to where the party occurred said she heard the gunshots, and when she later went outside in the daylight, she found four spent casings near her driveway, which she turned over to police. She didn't see who fired the gun but is concerned for her safety.

•On January 7th, around 11:20 p.m., police were dispatched to the area of Turney and Havana rds. for a report of two males wearing hooded sweatshirts breaking into vehicles. When police arrived they saw a man in a hooded sweatshirt walking down a driveway in the 12700 block of Havana and asked to speak with him. The male then fled on foot. Officers chased after the male, who kept reaching into his waistband. An officer in the foot pursuit believed the male may have had a gun so a Taser was deployed and struck the male in the back of the leg. He fell to the ground and was handcuffed.

The 18-year-old claimed he did not have any weapons, but when police pulled him up off the ground, they found a loaded handgun on the ground where the male had been handcuffed. He was taken to City Jail and was held for carrying a concealed weapon and obstructing official business.

A short time later, other officers in the area investigating the car break-ins located another suspect running from the Walgreens at the corner of Turney and Rockside rds. to the Shell gas station across the street. He did not use the crosswalk. Police detained and questioned him, and the 18-year-old claimed he had been acting as a "look out" while the first arrested male was breaking into cars throughout the city.

The 18-year-old was taken to City Jail for crossing the roadway outside of the sidewalk but was issued a citation and released on recognizance bond. He was later charged with conspiracy and attempting to commit theft.

### Cheese Cake

#### CRUST:

1 pkg. crushed graham crackers  
3 Tbsp. melted margarine  
2 Tbsp. sugar

#### FILLING:

3 (8 oz.) cream cheese  
6 eggs  
1 cup sugar  
1 tsp. vanilla

#### TOPPING:

1 pt. sour cream  
6 Tbsp. sugar  
1 tsp. vanilla

Combine crust ingredients and press into a 9x13 pan.

Cream the cream cheese, sugar and eggs one at a time. Add vanilla. Beat well. Pour into crust. Bake at 300° for 1 hour. Cool for 1 hour.

Combine ingredients for topping and pour over top of cooked cheese cake. Bake at 300° for 10 minutes.

### Stuffed Mushrooms

¼ stick butter

1 medium/large onion  
2 (12 oz.) pkgs. mushrooms  
1 lb. Bob Evans Original bulk sausage  
1 (8 oz.) pkg. cream cheese  
1 Tbsp. dried parsley

**Preliminaries:** Set one oven rack 5½ inches from the broiler element. Set the other rack about 5 inches or so below that. Preheat oven to 350°.

In a skillet, melt butter over medium heat. Slowly cook onion for 30 minutes, stirring often. Remove stems from mushrooms. Chop and set aside. Clean mushroom caps with damp paper towels, set aside.

Brown sausage in a large skillet for three minutes. Add the chopped mushroom stems and saute another minute.

Drain onions and mushroom/sausage mixture well. Place in mixer bowl. Add the cream cheese and

parsley, mixing well. Spoon mixture evenly into the mushroom caps. Place stuffed mushrooms on a foil lined baking sheet. Bake on the lower rack, uncovered, for 10 minutes. Move baking sheet to the top rack and broil for 5 minutes at 400°.

**Variations** Instead of using plain pork sausage, substitute any sausage of choice, such as turkey, Italian, Polish, etc.

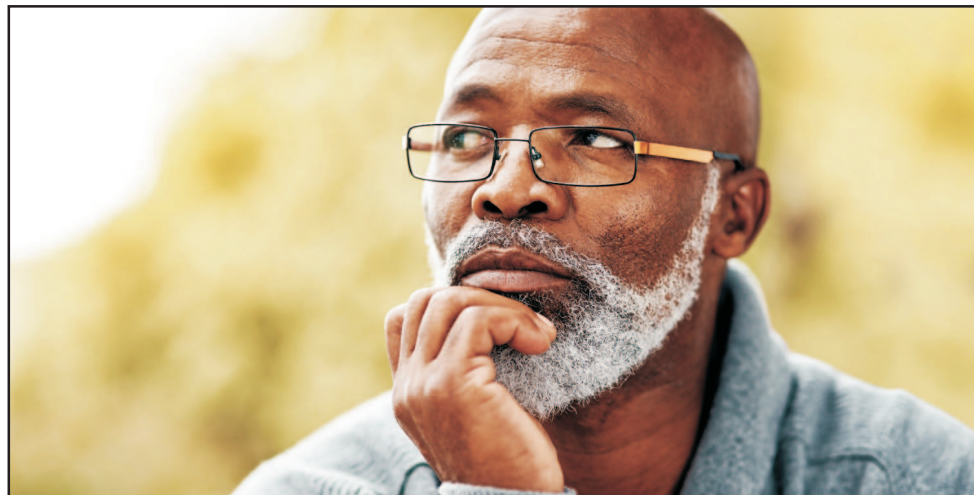
