Harvard Ave. over I-77 to close for 180 days

Beginning Thursday, March 28, the Harvard Avenue bridge over I-77 in Newburgh Heights will close for 180 days for a bridge replacement, according to a press release from the Ohio Department of Transportation.

"I am pleased that the last of the bridges over this stretch of I-77 is getting completed," said Tony Brancatelli, Cleveland Ward 12 Councilman. "We will have some disruptions of traffic, but this improved bridge will offer a more efficient design to accommodate both the highway underpass width and a bridge that can accommodate both pedestrian/bike and vehicular traffic."

I-77 will also have off-peak lane closures and temporary complete closures to accommodate bridge demolition and construction operations over the next several weekends, according to the press release. Eastbound Harvard Avenue vehicles will detour via I-77 southbound to Grant Avenue to I-77 northbound to Harvard Avenue. Westbound Harvard Avenue vehicles will detour via I-77 northbound to Pershing Avenue to I-77 southbound to Harvard Avenue.

The project was awarded to the Ruhlin Company for \$6,073,897 and is expected to be completed by October.

Frank Austin named BGCC Youth of the Year

Frank Austin, a senior at Max S. Hayes High School and a youth leader in the Slavic Village neighborhood, has been named the Boys & Girls Clubs of Cleveland's Youth of the Year for 2019.

Frank, 18, who attends the Broadway Club and is a junior staff member there, was honored at last Friday's BGCC Breakfast of Champions and Youth of the Year Recognition event at Cuyahoga Community College.

Finishing second was Ti'yonna Scott of John Adams High School and the John Adams Teen Center, while Danesha McKinney and Doriann Johnson, both students at Jane Addams Business Career Center and members of the King Kennedy Club, tied for third.

Frank, who will now move on to state competition April 5-6 in Perrysburg, Ohio, said he was angry and in need of direction when he and his siblings lost their mother unexpectedly four years ago.

"I found that direction at Boys & Girls Clubs of Cleveland," he said. "They had everything — a basketball court, games, computers, books and music. Most importantly, it was a place where I could just be a teen."

At Friday's event, Cuyahoga Community College President Alex Johnson gave the keynote address and was honored as Youth Champion of the Year. Master of ceremonies was WEWS anchor Frank Wiley.

Event sponsors were Tri-C and Medical Mutual.

Frank has been an honor roll student and a P-16 Youth Leader for Slavic Village Development. In addition, he co-facilitated "Stop the Hate" events at his Club and diagnosed mechanical problems during Ohio City's

Two dead, one hurt in Maple Hts. shooting

Maple Heights police responded to a man's Tabor Avenue home on Saturday, March 16, at about 1:20 a.m. after he reported an unknown male at his door calling for help. The caller was unable to clearly understand what the male was saying.

Officers arrived and discovered that the male, later identified as Christian Lett, 31, had sustained gunshot wounds. As they provided first aid assistance and waited on the arrival of Maple Heights Fire/Rescue, police dispatch received another call. The caller reported that there had been shots fired in the area of 14400 Brunswick Avenue. Additional officers responded to this area and found an open door at the residence with what appeared to be blood.

Officers cleared the residence and located two males, later identified as Willie G. Ivy II, 35, and Julius Moore, 29, who had also sustained gunshot wounds. Both males were deceased. Christian Lett was transported to Metro Hospital with life-threatening injuries. Maple Heights Police determined Lett ran from the Brunswick Avenue residence to Tabor Avenue. They are conducting an investigation with the assistance of the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation.

"The investigation is at a standstill at this time," said Det. Lt. D. Grossmyer of the Maple Heights Police Department. "We are working with several agencies on the case on possible people of interest."

Cuyahoga County to award millions for local resurfacing, preventative maintenance programs

Cuyahoga County Council will consider the approval of \$2 million in funding for various projects under the 2019 and 2020 Local Resurfacing Program as part of the Department of Public Works' Roadway Capital Program. In addition, the county is granting \$2.8 million for its annual Preventative Maintenance Program.

In the next few weeks, a council committee will con-

sider approving several 2019 projects, which will be funded from a new \$5 fee for license renewals, according to cleveland.com.

The Roadway Capital Program was developed to assist municipalities in the completion of projects on local county roads. The \$2 million for local resurfacing and \$2.8 million for preventative maintenance will match

funds secured by the municipalities for a total estimated program of \$10.7 and \$7 million, respectively.

Municipalities in the southeast Cleveland area expected to receive funding for 2019 include:

- Bedford/Oakwood: Forbes Road from Northfield Road to Broadway Avenue (\$388,000)
- Garfield Heights: Canal Road between north and south corporation lines (\$422,000)
- Maple Heights: Dunham Road from Turney Road to south corporation line (\$246,500)

For the Local Resurfacing Program, municipalities are eligible for 50 percent funding of their projects, up to \$250,000 per project. These projects are designed and constructed by the municipality with county review. The county reimburses eligible costs at the conclusion of the project. This award is in addition to the previously programmed 2019 Local Resurfacing Program, made possible by license fees, bringing the total awarded by the county for this program to \$5 million.

The Preventative Maintenance Program entails the county covering material costs and municipalities covering the cost of labor, with a cap of \$200,000 per municipality per year for roadway maintenance items such as crack sealing, patching and catch basin repair. Projects are selected based on traffic volume, road condition and the project's cost. All municipalities that applied for the Preventative Maintenance Program were at least awarded a portion of their requested funds.

"Strong infrastructure is a critical need in our county," said County Executive Armond Budish. "The county continues to find innovative ways to assist our municipalities, even as state and federal funds are diminishing. I am pleased to see our county and local city officials collaborating to get these road resurfacing projects completed."

"Our programs focus on being proactive in addressing the needs of the regional transportation system while partnering with cities and other funding partners to maximize the use of our resources," said Michael Dever, director of the Department of Public Works.

Three resolutions were passed at the Wednesday, March 13, meeting of the Village of Cuyahoga Heights Council, the first a memorial resolution for Donna L. Derbin. The other two resolutions authorized an easement agreement with Westinghouse Air Brake Technologies Corporation for constructing and maintaining sewers, and a change order with CTL Engineering, Inc. for slope failure evaluations on East 71st Street at the I-77 crossover.

Motions were approved unanimously to authorize the village’s chief financial officer to make the following purchases:

- Police department and jail upgrades needed to relocate dispatch to the Chagrin Valley Dispatch not to exceed \$35,000;
- Fire department upgrades also needed to relocate to Chagrin Valley Dispatch not to exceed \$20,000;
- Dispatch department upgrades not to exceed \$35,000 needed to relocate to Chagrin Valley Dispatch;
- Services for the annual

operation and maintenance within the village for sewer and catch basin video, jetting and cleaning for the 2019 season, not to exceed \$35,000;

- Annual pavement repairs for the 2019 season, not to exceed \$35,000.

The Finance Committee approved payment of \$6000 to the Senior Citizens Committee for annual expenses.
