Independence, Maple, Cuyahoga Hts. football teams make playoffs

The Ohio High School Athletic Association released the pairings for the first round of the football playoffs Sunday. On August 1, 715 OHSAA member schools began practice, and now 224 schools have qualified for the playoffs, according to Tim Stried, OHSAA director of communications.

Maple Heights High School, Cuyahoga Heights High and Independence High have all qualified for the first round of playoffs.

Division II Maple Heights (7-3) will play at Avon Lake (9-1) on Friday, November 8, at 7 p.m.

Division VII Malvern (5-5) will play at Cuyahoga Heights (8-1) on Saturday, November 9, at 7 p.m.

Division VII Warren John F. Kennedy (7-3) will play at Independence (7-3) November 9, at 7 p.m.

Police track down juvenile offender in Slavic Village

According to several local news organizations and the US Marshals Service, a 14-year-old boy wanted for attempted murder and several other felony charges was tracked down in Cleveland's Slavic Village neighborhood on Monday.

Cleveland police gave chase when the boy jumped out of a car and attempted to run from officers. He was quickly caught and arrested, according to news sources. He is now being charged in Cuyahoga County Juvenile Court.

Other charges include discharging a firearm multiple times, felonious assault multiple times, having weapons under disability and carrying a concealed weapon, according to media reports.

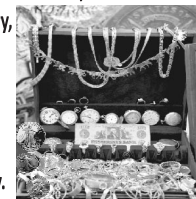

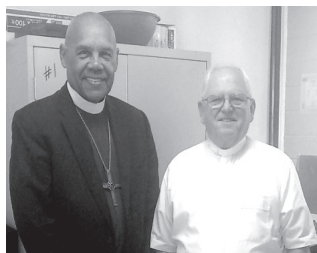

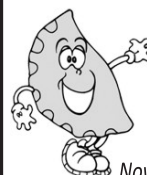

Reader's CHOICE RECIPES

SVICKOVA (Beef Sauerbraten)

Marinade:

- 1 large onion, sliced
- 2 stalks celery, chopped
- 1 carrot, sliced
- ¼ cup vinegar
- 1 ½ cups water
- 1 T salt
- 6 whole allspice
- 10 peppercorns
- 2 bay leaves

Boil together all above ingredients; cool. Have ready 4 to 5 lbs. boneless rump or chuck roast. Pour vegetables and marinade over meat and refrigerate for 2 days. Butter roasting pan. Remove meat from marinade and put in pan. Put 2 T butter

over top and bake at 350° in a covered pan for 1 hour. Add some vegetable and part of strained juice. Cover and roast until tender. Strain brine; add more juice or water to brine for gravy. If you want it less sour, use water. Beat 4 T flour with 1 pint sour cream and add to brine to make gravy.

TOMATO SOUP SPICE CUPCAKES

- 1 box (about 18 oz.) spice cake mix
- 1 can (10 ¾ oz.) tomato soup
- ½ cup water
- 2 eggs

Preheat oven to 350°. Place paper liners in 24 muffin cups. Mix cake mix, soup, water and eggs according to package directions. Fill each muffin cup about half full. Bake 20 minutes or until toothpick tests clean. Cool on wire racks 10 minutes, then remove from pans and cool completely. Frost with your favorite cream cheese frosting.

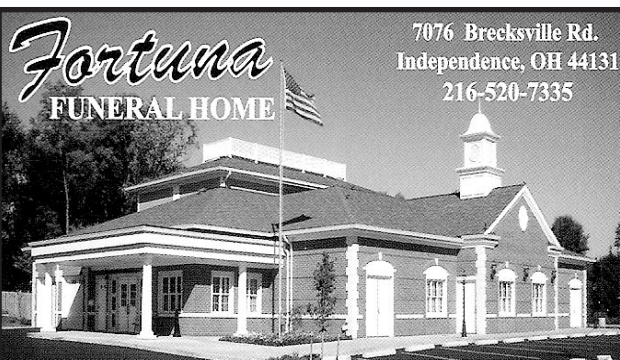
