Garfield Hts. Council raises pay for union, non-union employees

By Ellen Psenicka

Garfield Heights Mayor Vic Collova, during his report at the regular meeting of city council Monday night, said the legislative agenda would include "well deserved" 2% raises for union and non-union city employees, which were ultimately passed that night by council members.

He said these employees had not received a significant raise in the past two years.

The following ordinances were passed at Monday night's meeting:

- •To increase the number of captain positions by one and decrease the number of lieutenant positions by one now permitted in the Garfield Heights Fire De-
- •To authorize an amendment to the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the cityand Local 2729 and Council 8, AFSCME, AFLO-CIO to allow for a 2% pay raise retroactive to Jan. 1, 2020;
- •To amend and supplement the city's plan of classification and compensation for non-union employees to allow for a 2% pay raise;
- •To accept the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council Energized Community Grant for 2020. The city is eligible to receive \$74,558.
- •To enter into an agreement with Perk Company,

Senior levy renewal on August ballot, Stafford Park Pool improvements OK'd by Maple Heights Council

A renewal of an existing 1.3 mill tax levy benefiting the Maple Heights Senior Center, to appear on the August 4, 2020 ballot, and improvements to the Stafford Park Pool, with the goal of opening it back up to residents in the near future, were among the legislation approved by Maple Heights Council at its meeting last week.

Council approved the resolution to submit to Maple Heights voters the renewal of an existing 1.3 mill levy, "for payment of current expenses and general operations of the Maple Heights Senior Center," for another five-year period. The renewal was last approved by voters in 2015.

Last month the county fiscal officer noted that the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the levy would be \$336,876 annually during the life of the levy.

To help fulfill Mayor Annette Blackwell's stated intention to reopen Stafford Park Pool to residents, council passed two pieces of legislation last week for a Spray Ground Isolation Fence and a pool water main replacement project, as part of the Stafford Park Pool Reĥabilitation Project, to be funded by Cuyahoga County Department of Development Supplemental Grants (CDSG).

Great Northern Fence Company submitted the lowest and best proposal for the isolation fence, at a cost of \$10,996; and Terrace Construction Company Inc. submitted the lowest and best proposal for the water main repair project, at a cost of \$8,257.52, according to the legislation.

Economic development director approved

At last week's meeting, council also voted to approve the appointment of Patrick Grogan-Myers as economic development director for the city, Council Clerk Leonette Cicirella stated.

Grogan-Myers will receive an annual salary of \$75,000. plus a bonus of \$2,500 should he bring in new businesses to the city generating a minimum of \$100,000 in payroll.

Bedford Council accepts \$43,000 NOPEC grant

The city of Bedford is continuing its goal of making energy-related improvements in the community following council's passage of an ordinance to accept an additional \$43,000 grant from the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council (NOPEC) at its meeting last week.

The 2020 Energized Community Grant is offered to communities by NOPEC to make various energy improvements such as upgrades to municipal buildings and

Council also passed an ordinance authorizing an annual updating of various ordinances of the city of a general and permanent nature and also passed amendments to those needing changes to conform to state law.

Also approved was an ordinance amending previous legislation to establish pay ranges in the city.

City of Bedford Tax Auditor




