Congrats to Vic's Floral on their relocation to 6304 Fleet Ave. They recently outgrew their space at the corner of Broadway and E. 71 St., but with the assistance of Slavic Village Development Business Development Officer Marilyn Mosinski, they were able to relocate to the nearby Fleet Ave. storefront, officially opening last Tuesday, Feb. 11.

It was an emotional moment for longtime owner Drew Haney, who ran the business since 1977. He was proud to see his employee, Kelly Hastings, purchase the company in 2017 and keep it thriving as they enter a new era. Hastings first came to Vic's after answering a Craig's List ad by Haney 10 years ago for a part-time job and grew to love and then buy the business, keeping all six employees.

Pleasant Valley Rd. closure

In last week's administrative online report from Independence Mayor Gregory Kurtz, he announced that the Cuyahoga County Department of Public Works had notified the city that the bridge deck of the Pleasant Valley Road bridge over Canal Road/Towpath was in immediate need of repair.

Due to ongoing work in the westbound lane of the Pleasant Valley Road bridge spanning Independence and Valley View, he said, this stretch of roadway will be intermittently closed. Two-way traffic will be maintained in a single lane by portable traffic signals. Vehicles traveling in the area should expect delays and may want to consider alternate routes.

The closure will remain in effect until county crews can finalize repairs. Repairs should be completed by the end of March 2020, weather permitting. Signs notifying travelers will be installed on Pleasant Valley Road at the intersections of Brecksville Road and Hub Parkway.

Newburgh Hts. passes bill to support plastic bag ban

At its regular meeting on Tuesday, Feb. 4, Newburgh Heights Council passed legislation in support of the Cuyahoga County Council ordinance banning use of disposable plastic bags, which went into effect Jan. 1, 2020, with enforcement by the county being delayed until July 1, 2020.

The Newburgh Heights legislation states that it "anticipates that Cuyahoga County will enforce its ordinance within the boundaries of the Village of Newburgh Heights." It goes on to say that the village "desires to combat the polluting effects of and accompanying blight caused by disposable bags on the environment of the village."

Other legislation approved by council included an ordinance to consolidate the pay, remuneration and benefits provisions for all police department personnel.

Also passed was the transfer of property and improve-

ments at 3938 E. 41 St. from the village to the Newburgh Heights Community Improvement Corporation.

An ordinance to create the full-time, at-will position of police department and village hall support administrator was okayed to provide additional administrative help to the clerk of court, police department and finance department.

Resolutions were passed in support of the Medicare For All Act of 2019, celebrating Black History Month and proclaiming American Heart Month in the village.

Resolutions were also approved to accept a gift of \$1000 from American Legion Post 627 for the village's Thanksgiving Dinner program and to accept a gift of 52 frozen turkeys valued at \$912.50 from 1-888 OHIOCOMP, a managed care organization, also for the village's Thanksgiving Dinner program.

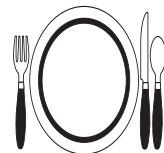

For example:

Question - Do I have to register my dog?

Answer - Yes. You are required to register any dog older than three months with the county auditor. If the dog doesn't have its tags, it can be impounded. Codified Ordinance Section 505.03.

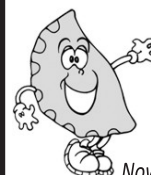

Indy places moratorium on electronic changeable signs

Independence Council met on Tuesday, Feb. 11, and placed a 120-day moratorium on all electronically changeable signs within the city.




The legislation defines these signs as those whose display uses multiple or changing messages whether by electronic or mechanical means. The bill states that the city will not accept any application or issue any permits or variances for any electronically changeable signs for the 120-day period, during which time the city will research and present to council revisions to the codified ordinances to regulate the use of these signs.

Also passed were the following ordinances:

- Accepting the bid of Three-Z-Inc. for the purchase of yard waste processing services for the service department on an as-needed basis;
- Accepting the bid of Fisher Auto Parts, Inc. for the supply of various automotive and light truck parts for the service department;
- Accepting the bid of Mason Company for the supply of janitorial goods for all city departments;
- Approving the proposal of GPD Group for professional engineering services in connection with the assessment of the city’s existing facilities;
- Accepting the bid of B&C Communications for the purchase and installation of a new bi-directional antenna system for the police department to provide radio communications into and out of the jail, enhancing officer safety and communication ability;
- Authorizing the purchase and installation of a poured rubber play surface for the Liberty Park Playground Improvements Project;
- Authorizing an easement agreement with Matthew and Danielle Franko at 4303 San Fernando Circle;
- Authorizing the retention of South Shore Utility Locating, Inc. for protective services relative to the city’s underground conduit system;
- Paying the Southwest Council of Governments for annual membership dues. This council supports regional fire and law enforcement response capabilities that would be cost prohibitive for a single city. Police Chief Michael Kilbane noted that the Council of Governments has requested a \$2500 increase in the annual dues for the Southwest Enforcement Bureau to replace an outdated armored vehicle for the SWAT team as well as funding the

new crowd control unit. Kilbane said this is the first dues increase requested in over 10 years, and urged passage of the ordinance to authorize the dues payment;



- Purchasing and delivery of five Freightliner trucks and a Swaploader hoist and Henderson snow and ice control systems for the service department.
