State auditor orders former Bedford Water Dept. employees to repay \$80,000 in stolen funds

Auditor of State Keith Faber last Tuesday, Feb. 25, released a special audit and criminal investigation of the city of Bedford which identified almost \$80,000 in monies collected by the city but not deposited into city bank accounts and issued a finding for recovery against former city Water Department clerks Linda Yarish and Joan Law, according to a news release issued by Faber's office.

"I commend the city of Bedford and my Special Investigations Unit on their work to uncover this abuse," Auditor Faber said. "Lying, cheating and stealing to obtain taxpayer dollars is a significant breach of public trust, and I will hold to account any public officials guilty of these crimes."

On Sept. 20, 2016, a city utility customer presented a receipt of payment to Yarish which had not been posted to the client's account. Yarish notified City Manager Mike Mallis of the incident. City video surveillance indicated Law had collected the payment.

Police Chief Kris Nietert and Mallis interviewed Law regarding the incident and she admitted to stealing from the Water Department. As a result, the city terminated Law and on September 29, 2016, the city contacted the auditor's office to report the theft.

The city also suspected Yarish of theft, so they reviewed receipts collected on days when Law was absent and found \$574 in missing funds for May 20, 2016 – May 31, 2016, a period when Law was on vacation. The city then terminated Yarish as well.

On Dec. 12, 2016, the auditor's office initiated a special audit of the city of Bedford Water Department's utility collections. Auditors uncovered 714 receipts totaling \$76,869 in which monies collected were not deposited into the city bank account.

Yarish and Law were the only two city employees responsible for collecting, processing and depositing Water Department receipts. As such, the auditor's office, so the news release notes, reviewed their leave records and identified the following:

- There were 50 days where Law was solely responsible for the day's receipt collections as Yarish was absent from work. On those days, auditors identified 182 receipts totaling \$19,359.

- There were 18 days in which Yarish was solely responsible for the day's collections as Law was absent from work. For those days, auditors identified 58 receipts totaling \$7,183.

- There were 142 days where both Yarish and Law were jointly responsible for the day's collections. For those days, auditors identified 474 receipts totaling \$50,327.

Auditor Faber issued a finding for recovery against Law for \$19,359, against Yarish for \$7,183, and against them both, jointly and severally, for \$50,327.

The city has subsequently implemented improved internal controls by adding user identification tracking for all transactions and restricted administrative access. Auditor Faber recommends the city continue to pursue improvements to their policies and periodically evaluates their effectiveness.

Newburgh Heights Council notes

The Village of Newburgh Heights Council met on Tuesday, Feb. 18, and passed two ordinances.

The first modified the fee for use of a police vehicle, which is usually for construction jobs. The old fee was \$75 for 8 hours; the new fee is a minimum of \$40 or \$10 an hour, whichever is greater.

The second ordinance passed by council authorized Mayor Trevor Elkins to enter into a Letter of Agreement with Partners Environmental, Inc. for groundwater monitoring services for Bert Avenue Landfill Post Closure Monitoring for 2021.

Mayor Elkins also approved the appointment of Brandon Cagwin to full-time patrol officer for the NHPD, effective Feb. 23.

Fire last Saturday above former Mojo's Bar in G.H.

Extensive fire damage was reported in apartments above the old Mojo's Bar and Grill at 4666 Warner Rd., Garfield Heights, last Saturday, about 8 p.m., as GHFD battled a blaze there, along with mutual aid from the Maple Heights, Valley View and Cuyahoga Heights fire departments.

GHPD officers were also on scene and were flagged down by a man who said he was house sitting for the owner of the building, Marlon Davis. He told police he was inside the east apartment of the building that evening and decided to fry up some fish and watch television.

He said at some point the pan caught fire and he threw water on the pan, causing the fire to spread. He then ran from the building. Police said he was the only occupant.

Police confirmed with Davis that the man had been house sitting.

GHFD successfully extinguished the fire, and the state fire marshal responded to the scene and will assist with the investigation.

Indictments secured against human trafficking suspect, alleged customer

Ohio Attorney General Dave Yost, Cuyahoga County Prosecutor Michael O'Malley and U.S. Department of Homeland Security Investigations Special Agent in Charge Vance Callander last Wednesday announced in a news release the arrests of a human trafficking suspect and an alleged customer.

The Cuyahoga County Regional Human Trafficking Task Force secured indictments on Feb. 25 for the human trafficking-related crimes for Rev. Dr. Randolph Brown, 64, of Maple Heights, according to cleveland.com, and Joyce Richmond, 21, a Cuyahoga County resident.

Brown was charged with two counts of compelling

prostitution (F3); and Richmond was charged with two counts of trafficking in persons (F1) and three counts of compelling prostitution (F3). Both entered not-guilty pleas at a hearing, and the case was assigned to Judge Cassandra Collier-Williams.

Brown is free on bond, and the state has filed for more discovery before court proceedings continue.

The Inner City Missionary Baptist Church, 1643 E. 55 St., Cleveland, lists Brown as its pastor on the church's website.

"Indictments of coordinated operations like this don't happen accidentally," Yost said. "It's the great work of our

task force and partners in law enforcement, as well as Prosecutor O'Malley's office, who will now ensure that these traffickers stay behind bars."

The indictments culminate an investigation into Richmond and her exploitation of three underage teenage girls who had run away from home, according to Ohio Attorney General Yost's news release.

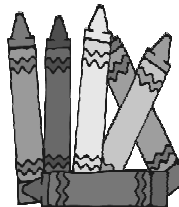

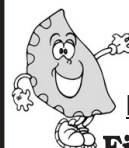

Laws of the Land in Garfield Heights

Do you live in Garfield Heights and have a question about its ordinances - what may or may not be legal in any given circumstance? This column will answer your questions with the help of members of Garfield Heights City Council.

Question - Does the city require me to maintain and repair my house and property?

Answer - Yes. Garfield Heights has an exterior maintenance code. Building inspectors inspect all buildings and houses to ensure that they are up to code. If a violation is found, you will be cited. Failure to correct violations is treated as a criminal case, and is a misdemeanor of the first degree, carrying a maximum penalty of 180 days in jail and a \$1000 fine.
