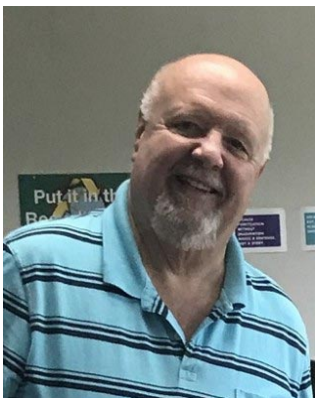

## M.H. Council OKs security cameras for Stafford Park

In the interest of improving safety for residents and helping police respond to potential criminal activity, Maple Heights Council passed legislation at its teleconference meeting last week to approve a contract with Step CG to install security cameras at Stafford Park.

Step CG, based in Covington, Kentucky, submitted the lowest and best proposal for the project, which will include cameras and accompanying equipment, at a cost of \$44,000, according to the legislation.

The cost will be paid entirely out of \$100,000 in funding which has been allocated to Maple Heights from the State of Ohio, earmarked for improvements and senior and youth recreational programs.

It was noted in the resolution that Police Chief Todd Hansen had informed Mayor Annette Blackwell "that the lack of security cameras has little impact on discouraging and preventing loitering, vandalism and other criminal behavior which are a direct threat to public safety."

Much of the cost of the project would be spent on infrastructure for the camera system, Hansen said. He noted that Step CG would install 10 cameras throughout the park.

Blackwell said she was "dismayed" when a gazebo at the park burned down three years ago, and the city has been working on plans to address criminal activity at the park.

According to Maple Heights police reports, Stafford Park has been the scene of several violent incidents, including homicides, in recent years.

Blackwell said that installing the improved lighting and camera system would help cut down on the potential for further crimes in the park, which has been shut down due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, but is expected to reopen once the pandemic threat passes.

# Garfield Heights Council news

In a short agenda, Garfield Heights Council Monday night passed three emergency ordinances, one regarding city-issued electronic equipment.

The city intends to provide city council members with laptops to assist in their duties as digital communication has become essential during the pandemic. This necessitated amending a section of the codified ordinances to ensure any city official who is given city-issued property, such as a laptop computer, has the obligation to return it upon leaving city employment.

In a related matter, Council President Matt Burke announced Monday night that the next council meeting, scheduled for Nov. 9, will be held via Zoom instead of the teleconference call that has been the norm since the required virtual meetings.

Another ordinance passed authorizes city participation in the Ohio Public Works Commission State Capital Improvement Program for the Multi-Street Reconstruction and Waterline Replacement Project – Phase 6, in order to secure grant funds.

Council also authorized the purchase of a 2021 Ford F750 truck for the service department.

Mayor Vic Collova announced the retirement of longtime Service Director Tim McLaughlin, effective Friday, Oct. 30, and named service department foreman Dave Sikon as his replacement. Collova also said Paul Birk with the service department has been named recreation director, a vacancy created when Recreation Director Bob Dobies passed away suddenly last year.

## Drug dealer sentenced to 11 years in overdose death of fellow Bedford man

Cuyahoga County Prosecutor Michael C. O'Malley announced last week that Mark Wisniewski, 43, was sentenced to 11 years in prison for selling heroin that caused the death of a 59-year-old Bedford man in March 2015.

On March 11, 2015, the victim's mother called 911 after finding her son unresponsive in the basement of their Bedford residence near Edgewood and Mapledale aves. Bedford Police and Emergency Medical Services responded and found the victim deceased of an apparent overdose.

In January 2018, the DNA profile hit in CODIS to Wisniewski, also of Bedford, after he was arrested and charged in Summit County for selling heroin that caused the death of a 22-year-old woman in Twinsburg. In that case, he was sentenced to eight years in prison after a jury found him guilty of involuntary manslaughter, corrupting another with drugs and trafficking in drugs.

In September 2020, Wisniewski waived his right to a jury trial in Cuyahoga County. Judge Dick Ambrose found him guilty of one count of involuntary manslaughter, one count of corrupting another with drugs, one count of trafficking in drugs and one count of drug possession.

## M.H. Council approves

(Continued from Page 1)

Maple Heights Land Reutilization Program (land bank), to sell almost seven acres of city-owned land in the Warrensville Center-Libby Road area to PIRHL Acquisitions, LLC, for a senior living facility to be known as "Hazelwood Court," was placed on first reading, with a presentation and discussion expected at an upcoming Committee of the Whole meeting.

As stated in the ordinance, PIRHL, based in Cleveland, has proposed to develop and construct in the city a 50-unit senior living facility, including a 44-unit three-story building and six one-unit cottages, that will provide a quality housing option for seniors ages 55 or older.

PIRHL wants to purchase up to 39 separate but adjoining parcels of land, consisting of approximately 6.89 acres, located on the "paper streets" (only existing on maps) of Edinboro, Jackson and Hazelwood streets, "at a fair market value of \$470,900... less the amount of public improvement costs, currently estimated to be \$201,605," the legislation states.

Grogan-Myers spoke at the meeting about the project

and explained, "This partnership will bring affordable housing to the city and ensure we can keep our senior residents in the community they know and love."

### Other legislation

Council passed a resolution at the meeting authorizing Blackwell to apply to the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) for a potential grant to fund two capital infrastructure improvement projects for next year: replacement of water mains on Mendota and Rowena aves., and a manhole sewer separation project, Phase 2, for the northeast quadrant of the city.

Hren stated that the city received a \$1.6 million grant from the Cleveland Water Department for the water line project, and as an additional part of the project, the city was applying for \$670,000 in funding in the form of a grant from the OPWC. "The goal is to cost the city of Maple Heights zero," he said.

As for the sewer repairs, in the Hansen, Watson, Raymond, Warrensville Center and Northfield road areas, Hren said the city had received \$1.1 million in funding from the NEORS, but was seeking additional funds from the OPWC to include resurfacing as part of the work.

Also passed was a resolution authorizing Blackwell to enter into a contract with Specialized Construction, Inc., to provide services for the Schreiber Road Compost Facility Rehabilitation Project, at a cost of \$23,900.

The city successfully applied to the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District (NEORS) for Community Cost Share Funds in the amount of \$87,500, to be used for obtaining leaf collection equipment and rehabilitation of the existing municipal composting facility at 14580 Schreiber Rd., the resolution states.

In correspondence to council, Hren stated that the city had obtained leafvac equipment at a cost of \$57,000, which was paid out of the Community Cost Share Program funds.

Council also approved a resolution to enter into a contract with the Cuyahoga County Board of Health to provide health services for the city for 2021, at a cost of \$126,102.
