## Burke chastises Garfield Council for 'disrespecting' its city directors

Garfield Heights Mayor Matt Burke, in his report to council at its Monday night meeting, expressed his disappointment that members had seen fit to place the city directors present at council meetings at a small table away from where they had previously been seated at the table with council members. He also noted that at the last meeting City Engineer Dave Krock was not asked to give a report.

Burke, his anger barely below the surface, said all the directors and city employees have been going "above and beyond," with many routinely doing all kinds of work not in their job descriptions to keep the city running efficiently and economically.

City Council President Tom Vaughn said it was merely an oversight that Krock was not called on initially at the last meeting for a report and he would make sure it never happened again.

Ward 2 Councilman Charles Donahue said he was responsible for the small table for the directors and said it was Covid-motivated in the interest of social distancing of council seats.

"After tonight that table will be gone," Donahue told the mayor.

All other council members

expressed their regret at the miscommunication and praised the city directors and their employees for their hard work and dedication to Garfield Heights.

Burke wasn't the only one upset with council Monday night. At the Comments by Citizens portion of the meeting, former councilman Joe LaMalfa told council members he was worried about a lack of transparency in some of their actions.

He said a new clerk of council had been named, but only two people had applied for the position. LaMalfa said he had checked online and in The Neighborhood News and nowhere could he find the position advertised.

He also noted that council had informally decided not to have a December 27th meeting, but no motion had

## Brancatelli objects to Ward 12 site for new jail; wants public meeting

In correspondence this week with Cuyahoga County Executive Armond Budish, Ward 12 Cleveland Councilman Tony Brancatelli informed him he strongly objected to the county's top choice to build a new jail at the Job Ready site in Ward 12 between Fleet and Pershing aves. Brancatelli called it "an inappropriate use of that land and location."

The county's second choice for the new jail would be a site in Ward 3, currently a shipping container yard at Orange and Broadway aves.

Last week Brancatelli was informally told that the county, without notifying the city, the city's Planning Commission or the sitting council member, intends to move forward with locating the new jail at the Job Ready site in Ward 12.

The city had created a Community Improvement Corporation (CIC) to facilitate clean up and marketing of the proposed Ward 12 site for general industry, which had been a steel mill slag site.

"The Job Ready site between Fleet and Pershing aves. is a great example of a brownfield reclamation project that was developed to create new jobs," Brancatelli told The Neighborhood News. "I look forward to a new general industry use that meets these goals."

A resolution coming before the new council when it meets in January objecting to the county's choice of the Ward 12 site for the new jail gives the following reasons why:

- The state provided resources to do the environmental remediation of this brownfield site but the funds provided have restrictions on the end user which prohibits a governmental agency from utilizing it.
- The Job Ready site was created and developed for general industry to create new jobs, and this 40-acre site is considered the largest industrial land opportunity in the city since the mid-1900s.
- The alternative proposal to use this site for a container storage facility in exchange for freeing up other land for the jail also defies the intent for the use of this location.
- Both a jail and a container storage facility on this site is in contravention to what the site was created for and would negate all the hard work that was done to create the site as a Job Ready site and would destroy all future job development and potential taxes coming to the city and the region as a whole.
- It is incumbent upon the county to engage local city leadership as well as the community in selecting the appropriate site for its new jail; the residents and businesses of our community deserve a public meeting.

The proposed council resolution goes on to say that, "This Council strongly opposes Cuyahoga County's selection of the Job Ready site at Fleet and Pershing aves. in Ward 12 as the location of the new jail."

been made at the meeting to that effect. That motion was made and passed as soon as LaMalfa sat down.

LaMalfa requested Vaughn to email him a response to the transparency issue in lieu of taking time out at the meeting.

### Legislation passed

•Emergency ordinance to apply for Community Development Block Grant funds and enter into an agreement with the Cuyahoga County Department of Development to create a sidewalk along Antenucci Blvd.

•Ordinance to apply for Community Development Supplemental Grant funds and enter into an agreement with the Cuyahoga County Department of Development to develop a Recreation Center master plan.

A resolution to appoint Mark Svoboda to the Recreation Board was withdrawn because Svoboda, an ODOT retiree, was prohibited from earning any additional income or his health insurance savings account, which amounts to \$600 annually, would be eliminated. He did, however, tell council he would be willing to serve as an unpaid volunteer.

Garfield Heights Ward 7 resident Lottie Overby was welcomed as the new city council clerk, and Building Commissioner Mark Moro, during his report to council,

said several new businesses are coming to the city, and the Sunoco station at Turney and Rockside rds. "is going to totally rebuild."

## GARFIELD HEIGHTS

### Weapon Offense

On Dec. 2, about 3 p.m., GHPD units were dispatched to the 4800 block of E. 84 St. when callers reported shots fired in that area. Other callers reported that the incident happened in the parking lot of the Venture Inn, E. 86 St. and Garfield Blvd. No suspects were located. An officer found one spent shell casing in the bar's parking lot. As officers were clearing the call, dispatch advised that a caller had just observed the suspect that fired the gun on E. 85 St. Police responded and arrested one juvenile and recovered a handgun.

### Menacing

On Nov. 29, at about 7:10 p.m., an officer responded to the 5500 block of Andover Blvd. to speak with a female regarding an incident at Pizza Hut. She told the officer that about 6:30 p.m. she was picking up her food from Pizza Hut, 5526 Turney Rd. She got her food and left, but returned when she found that her phone was missing. The staff said they had not seen a phone. The female noticed a male with long dreadlocks sitting by where she had been and suspected him of taking her phone. When she confronted him, he stood up and got a handgun from his waistband and cornered her to the wall saying, "I'll rob you right here; don't accuse me of taking your (expensive)." She replied "okay" and went home and called police.

An officer spoke with the Pizza Hut manager and said an incident had occurred between a female customer and a Door Dash delivery driver, and confirmed that he pulled out a gun after the female had accused him of stealing her phone and threatened to shoot her. The suspect got the order and left in a dark-colored, older model Buick

sedan. Surveillance video confirmed the victim's story.

Police located the suspect, but the victim could not positively ID him. She was advised to follow up with the Detective Bureau. The suspect has not been ruled out pending further investigation.

### Felonious Assault

On Dec. 13, at 11:19 p.m., officers were dispatched to the 12900 block of Oakview Blvd. for a male shot in the back. The caller said her son returned home with a gunshot wound. When police arrived the victim's mother said her juvenile son was shot and inside the house. The victim approached police at the front door. His face was sweaty but otherwise stable. He told officers he was shot in the back and buttocks area. Police observed two gunshot wounds, one in his lower back and the other in the left

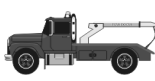
