# From the Mayor's Desk

### Our youth are a top priority

I wanted to take this opportunity to address the fear, uncertainty and frustration in the city of Maple Heights concerning our youth.

There are many comments being made and a perception that there is nothing for our youth to do given that the city pool is not open and there is no recreation center. More concerning to me is that it is believed that this administration is apathetic about youth engagement and the plight of our young people.

I want to take this opportunity to share my sincere passion and commitment to our youth and the families of the city of Maple Heights. My family and I have lived in the city for almost 25 years. I raised my three children here and now five grandchildren are growing up here so I have a very personal and vested interest in youth enrichment and their success. This includes advanced opportunities, internships, fellowships, mentorship, recreation and sports activities, even foreign exchange student experiences to develop an international student awareness to achieve and compete globally and to see a world bigger and farther than Maple Heights.

Heights City Schools successful 2012 Levy chairperson and for three years the Parent Academy Coordinator, a parenting skill-building program whose primary focus was to improve child school behavior and performance. Therefore, my contribution to this city began in the city schools. When I ran and won for mayor, I knew that I would be in a more influential and impactful position to better serve all the needs of the families in the city. I am honored to say that the members of this administration have consistently and intentionally worked hard to achieve an improved quality of life for every citizen and business owner here.

We overcame the city's fiscal challenges and are out of debt! # Three rescued from water at Viaduct Park in Bedford

Bedford firefighters responded to two separate water rescue calls in the Viaduct Park area of the city on Sunday, July 18, and all the individuals were successfully rescued, Bedford Fire Lt. Brian Harting stated.

At 1:39 p.m. on Sunday, the fire department received a call for a male who was swept through the viaduct and went down the chute, Harting stated. He said the male was pulled to shore by a bystander who had been in the area and saw the victim was in need of assistance. After firefighters assessed the male's injuries, they determined the need for assistance from the EastTech Rescue team to perform a slope evacuation to get the victim to the Glenns picnic area, and the victim was transported for further treatment and evaluation, Harting said.

Later that same day, at 7:03 p.m., Harting reported that firefighters received a call for two children who were also swept through the viaduct and down the chute. "The children were located and removed from the water safely," he said. "For a period of time it was believed their mother had gone in after them and was possibly missing, but she as later located and the incident was terminated

Harting explained, "Both of these incidents were related to the amount of rain and rapid flooding that had occurred within the last few days. Flood waters can be extremely dangerous. 



Bill Kray (1949-2020) ignited his photographic vision while working as a student photographer for The Lantern newspaper at The Ohio State University in the early 70's. He cultivated his perspective across a range of genres including landscapes, interiors, portraiture and figures. His work was exhibited at the Akron Art Institute and Butler Institute of American Art, and published in American Photographer magazine. This show honors his memory with selected works of form, style and subject matter he captured across decades of his generous life. Bill Kray's creativity and kind hearted way of seeing are in full focus.

# City Council passes million dollar bill to improve housing stock in Cleveland

Cleveland City Council held a meeting electronically last Wednesday and authorized spending up to \$1 million to fund a program aimed at improving the city's housing stock and the overall quality of life for residents. The money will allow the city to enter into contracts with various neighborhood development corporations, which will interview and hire staff for the initiative.

The aim of the Community Engagement Healthy Home Initiative is to restore all of the city's neighborhoods into safe, healthy and vibrant communities in which to live, work and raise families. Much of that initiative has been underway by nonprofit neighborhood development corporations, focusing on development, preservation, safety and new capital investments.

Besides hiring staff, the funding will allow the purchase of software, staff training and the purchasing of materials, equipment, supplies and services.
