### **Animal Cruelty in Garfield Heights**

On June 5, at about 7:35 p.m., an officer was dispatched to the 13100 block of Rexwood Ave. for a report of two dogs that had been abandoned in an apartment. Residents had complained about a foul smell coming from the apartment for the past one to two weeks and the complainant had discovered two pitbull/boxer dogs that had been abandoned. He then contacted GHPD. The officer observed the two dogs in cages, extremely malnourished, sitting in a large amount of feces and urine with no source of food or water. The apartment's air conditioning was not on and the temperature inside the apartment was about 100-degrees. The animal warden was notified and responded to the scene. Police noted that there was little to no information on the owner of the dogs other than possibly a name of the owner. The animal warden took possession of the dogs and will follow up with an investigation.

# Newburgh Heights Hires Full-time Fire Department

For the first time in its history, the Village of Newburgh Heights will be staffed with full-time firefighters. The inaugural staff was appointed on Monday, June 14, 2021 and ensures that the Village of Newburgh Heights is guaranteed the quality emergency response to which they have become accustomed.

Mayor Elkins stated, "the part-time staffing model was no longer sustainable due to the diminished recruiting Fire Chief Mike Wasielewski.

sizes in firefighter academy classes and the need to ensure our personnel were 100% committed to doing everything in their power to protect our residents against what is now the second most deadly pandemic in U.S. history.'

Fire Chief Brian Higginbotham added, "this is a plan that has been discussed between the Mayor and myself a number of times over the years and has always been our long-term objective. Staffing insecurity simply accelerated the timeline for implementation. I'm excited to take our department to the next level and provide an even more advanced level of security to the residents of Newburgh Heights than we have up to this date."

The inaugural class of full-time firefighters will consist of 6 firemen, a full-time Lieutenant, and our full-time Fire Chief representing over 100 years of experience. New firemen will make \$52,000 with annual raises. All appointments were unanimously approved by

"As Safety Director it is my responsibility to ensure the safety and security of our residents." That is exactly what I've asked Council to do and they've stepped up to the challenge. Now we have a staff whose first commitment is the residents of Newburgh Heights," said Mayor

# Neighborhood Pets expanding size, services

Neighborhood Pets is expanding its Wellness Clinic & Resource Center in Slavic Village into an empty storefront adjacent to its location.

By doubling in size, Neighborhood Pets, 3711 E. 65 St., will be able to increase walkin hours for wellness services and make more wellness appointments available.

The expansion is great for the neighborhood, filling in an empty storefront, but more importantly it's great for all the residents who need the help that Neighborhood Pets offers," said Ward 12 Councilman Tony Brancatelli.

Councilman Brancatelli has supported the center, with proceeds from the Ward 12 annual Pancake Breakfast as well as with block grant funding.

They've served over 4,000 Clevelanders since 2016 out of a 1,000 square-foot space, but there's an ever increasing demand. Since the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic, Neighborhood Pets has seen a significant increase in the number of Clevelanders who need help caring for their pets.

The organization's pet food bank served 50% more households in 2020. The increase in need, driven in large part by the Covid-19 pandemic, shows no sign of slowing down. Besides the pet food bank, Neighborhood Pets offers free spay/neuter, low-cost wellness care and pet supplies.

Unfortunately, the need for Neighborhood Pets services are greater than ever before," said Becca Britton, executive director of Neighborhood Pets.

Neighborhood Pets opened in Slavic Village five years ago, and the non-profit will be occupying a previously vacant and boarded up storefront adjacent to its existing Resource Center location.

There will be art installations and several major improvements on the building. Most recently completed is a mural installation in the new lobby by Cleveland artist Sean Kelly.

While the building/wellness clinic expansion is funded in part by lead sponsors PetSmart Charities and Embrace Pet Insurance, the nonprofit is open to donations, including buying items for the organization off its "wish list."

# Newburgh Heights Council passes mandatory vaccination of city employees, with exceptions

The Village of Newburgh Heights met in regular session on June 1, and amended the village's COVID-19 vaccination policy and authorized a stipend of \$500 to any village employee who demonstrates proof of full vaccination on or before Sept. 30, 2021.

The amended COVID-19 vaccination policy states that all employees of the village must obtain a COVID-19 vaccination. Exceptions to this policy are allowed for employees who maintain sincerely held religious beliefs protected under Title VII or have a medical condition which makes receipt of the vaccine dangerous or otherwise inappropriate for that individual.

The legislation states: "Where an employee qualifies for one of the exceptions, the village will seek to make a reasonable accommodation, depending on the facts and circumstances of the particular position and job duties. Where an employee meets either the religious beliefs or medical exceptions described herein and no reasonable accommodation can be made, such employee shall be placed on paid administrative leave until the United States Center for Disease Control lifts its state of emergency in connection with the COVID-19 pandemic.

"Thereafter, the employee shall be permitted to return to work. The safety director may consider requests for a reasonable accommodation from employees who do not meet an exception on a case-by-case basis.

"An employee will receive a written warning, to be placed in their personnel file, for noncompliance if the employee is not fully vaccinated on or before July 1, 2021. Where a reasonable accommodation cannot be made, an employee will receive a two-day suspension if the employee is not fully vaccinated on or before August 1, 2021. Where a reasonable accommodation cannot be made, an employee will be terminated if the employee is not fully vaccinated on or before September 30, 2021."

### Other legislation passed

Other council legislation passed included:

- •Amending penalty provisions for garbage and rubbish pickup violations. Whoever violates any provision of this section shall be subject to the following schedule of fines and penalties: \$50 fine upon a first offense; \$100 fine upon a second offense that occurs within 12 months of the first offense; \$250 fine upon a third offense that occurs within 12 months of the second offense; and \$250 fine and 1st degree misdemeanor charge for a fourth offense that occurs within 12 months of the third offense.
- •Entering into an affiliation agreement with Lake County Community College to provide EMS training.
- •Consolidating the pay, remuneration and benefits provisions for all fire department and police department personnel.

•Authorizing the mayor to enter into a Healthy Urban Tree Canopy Grant Program Year 2021 Project Agreement with the Cuyahoga County Planning Commission.

### Purchases and approvals

Also passed by council at its June 1 meeting was \$17,500 to Specialized Construction for pavement repairs to Harvard Ave.; appointment of Anthony Colon to the Newburgh Heights Police Department as a part-time officer.

Passed was \$47,555 to Dura Mark for street striping of Harvard Ave.; \$179,100 to OHM Advisors for preliminary engineering on Harvard Ave.; outfitting two Ford Interceptor SUV police cruisers by Hall Public Safety at a cost not to exceed \$35,000;

Approval of up to \$85,000 to purchase and demolish 4421 Harvard Ave.; up to \$85,000 to purchase and demolish 4425 Harvard Ave.; up to \$35,000 to the Newburgh Heights CIC for the purchase of 3881 E. 42 St.; and up to \$115,000 to purchase 5301 Harvard Ave.

Council also consented to spend up to \$44,941 to construct a pole barn in Kathy Edwards Park.

The next regularly scheduled meeting of Newburgh Heights Village Council is set for July 90




