Special G.H. meeting set for Davis to respond to allegations

Garfield Heights Council met in special session last Wednesday, March 24, to discuss the next step to be taken following the allegation at the March 22 regular meeting of council that Ward 4 Councilwoman Shayla Davis is presently employed by the city of Cleveland and is, therefore, in violation of the Garfield Heights City Charter in her position as a councilperson.

Council President Mike Nenadovich said the charter stipulates that Davis be notified in writing of the charge against her at least 10 days in advance of a public hearing. He called a special council Zoom meeting for Tuesday, April 13, at 6:30 p.m. at which time Councilwoman Davis will be able to address the allegations brought against her.

Community Police reports

Homicide Investigation

On Monday, March 29, at approximately 8:45 p.m., officers responded to the 5900 block of Hosmer Ave. for a male shot. On arrival the victim, age 20, was located in front of a home in the 6000 block of Hosmer with a gunshot wound to his neck. He was transported to University Hospitals by EMS where he was pronounced deceased.

Members of the Homicide Unit responded to the scene for investigation. Preliminary information indicates that

the victim and another male were walking down the street when they were approached by three other males and an exchange of gunfire occurred and the victim was shot. No arrests have been made. Detectives continue to investigate.

MAPLE HEIGHTS

Aggravated Robbery

On Wednesday, March 24, around 4 a.m., the Maple Heights Police Department received a call from a Lyft driver reporting he was carjacked at gunpoint by two male suspects he was transporting. The victim reported picking up the suspects from a residence in Maple Heights and taking them to the 17800 block of Waterbury, in Maple Heights. When the victim stopped, one of the suspects produced a pistol and struck the victim in the head. The suspects fled in the victim's vehicle, which is a blue 2016 Subaru Outback. The vehicle was later seen by multiple other agencies who pursued the vehicle but lost sight of it, terminating their pursuits.

The suspects were described as two black males in their early 20's. Both were armed. It is believed these same suspects may have also committed additional crimes in other cities throughout the evening. They should be considered armed and dangerous.

The Maple Heights Police Department is still investigat-

Traffic Offense – Fleeing

On March 24, at about 4:40 a.m., a BOLO alert (Be On the Look Out) was issued by Maple Heights Police for a blue Subaru Outback with temporary tags with suspects inside who had stolen the vehicle from a retired Cleveland Police detective. The alert said the suspects were two black males around 20-years-old who had hit the driver of the vehicle over the head and taken his car in an incident on Waterbury Ave., Maple Heights, about 4:06 a.m. They were armed with an AR 15-type assault rifle and were considered dangerous. Warrensville Heights police aided in the pursuit as did Garfield Heights when two officers patrolling in the area of Broadway Ave. and I-480 spotted the car swerving in and out of traffic without headlights heading east on Broadway.

The suspect car entered the on ramp of I-480 from Broadway at a high rate of speed. Officers activated the emergency lights on their patrol car and initiated a pursuit westbound on I-480 beyond Transportation Blvd. As the suspect vehicle reached speeds over 100 mph, the pursuit was terminated by police at the I-480 bridge.

Criminal Damage - Residence

Officers were dispatched shortly before midnight on March 26, for a report of criminal damage to a home in the 12800 block of Bangor Ave. Complainants said that evening unknown person(s) threw a medium-sized rock through the west side of a kitchen window. No suspects were observed before or after the incident.





Garfield Heights Summer Sports Programs

T-Ball & Co-ed Softball for boys and girls

By following the State of Ohio, Cuyahoga County and local guidelines, the city of Garfield Heights will be bringing back its summer sports programs. Registration for both T-Ball & Co-Ed Softball will be held at The Dan Kostel Rec Center, at 5411 Turney Rd., beginning April 1st through the May 5th deadline.

T-Ball is for ages 5-7 on or before July 1, 2020. Co-Ed Softball is for ages 7-15 on or before August 1, 2020. It is highly recommended that a 7-year-old has had at least one year in T-Ball.

Fees

Residents - \$40 + \$15 recreation ID card = \$55

Non-Residents - \$70 + \$40 recreation ID card = \$110

After May 5th deadline, there will be a \$15 late fee if applications accepted. So don't wait – Sign up Early!

Things to bring with you when registering

Birth Certificates required for ALL PLAYERS at the time

of registration, whether your child has played before or not.

Two current utility bills are required for proof of residency for ALL RESIDENTS. We accept cash, credit, debit and checks with current ID (drivers license) and only a parent or legal guardian can register a child.

Sign-ups must be done in a timely manner for team assignments, scheduling purposes, ordering uniforms and allowing scheduled practice times. Coaches are always needed – your time and talents will be greatly appreciated. Call the Rec Center if you would be interested. The office generally opens at 8 a.m. daily & will be open most evenings for your convenience. Moody's upgrades financial position of Maple Hts.

Last Wednesday, Moody's Investors Service upgraded the city of Maple Heights' issuer rating to Ba3 from B2. Concurrently, it has upgraded to Ba3 from B2 the rating on the city's outstanding general obligation limited tax debt. The outlook has been revised to positive from stable. The rating and outlook apply to \$9.4 million in outstanding GOLT debt.

"We were able to achieve this success because it became necessary for our city's survival," Mayor Annette Blackwell told the Neighborhood News. "It was abundantly clear to the elected officials and all of the extremely talented administrators that failure was not an option."

The upgrade to Ba3 reflects the city's significantly improved financial position, said Moody's.

Rating outlook

The positive outlook reflects the city's progress toward rebuilding operating reserves. While the improved financial position minimizes the probability of a near-term default, weak economic conditions will remain a challenge. The outlook also considers the likelihood of credit strengthening over the near term should the city continue to demonstrate structurally balanced financial operations.

Opinion summary

According to Moody's Credit Opinion summary published on March 25, Maple Heights has significantly improved its financial position, but will continue to be challenged by its high reliance on income taxes and a weak economic and demographic profile. The city's debt

burden is modest and amortization is rapid; however, the pension burden is high.
