Jennings and PIRHL to break ground on new senior apartments in Maple Hts.

The city of Maple Heights and Northeast Ohio organizations PIRHL and Jennings jointly announced last week that they will break ground on Thursday, Aug. 25, at 5 p.m., for a new senior apartment building at Thomas St. and Hazelwood Ave., in Maple Heights.

The new apartment name and construction timeline will be announced at the event, with the facility to open in 2023.

Maple Heights Mayor Annette Blackwell, Jennings' President and CEO Allison Q. Salopeck, and PIRHL President and CEO David Uram will lead the ceremonies and be joined by invited legislators, followed by refreshments and photo opportunities.

TV broadcaster to build facility in Indy

Gray Media Group, the second largest TV broadcaster in the country, received approval at the Aug. 9th meeting of Independence Council, to build a state-of-the-art broadcasting facility on Rockside Woods Blvd., North, adjacent to Topgolf.

Council granted Gray Media a special conditional use permit for the operation of an office building and broadcast and satellite equipment center.

"During preliminary discussions, a Gray representative told me they are drawn to Independence because of our prime location that gives them access to the entire media market and our proximity to highways, downtown and airports," Mayor Gregory Kurtz said in his report to council. "Also, we are a safe community for their employees who operate 24/7, 365 days a year."

Kurtz said Gray owns WOIO, WUAB and Telemundo Cleveland (WTCL).

Other legislation passed at last week's meeting included:

- Authorizing the mayor to enter into an agreement with Youth for Christ to provide program coordination and direction to run and staff the faith-neutral portion of the Campus Life Program for the 2022-2023 school year, in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00;

- Declaring the dwelling and accessory buildings at 7905 Stone Rd., to be unsafe and therefore, a public nuisance, as well as the junk motor vehicles parked on the property, and authorizing the law director to notify the owner;

- Purchasing a new sewer box truck for the service department in an amount not to exceed \$89,670;

- Purchasing two plow trucks and salt boxes for the service department in an amount not to exceed \$239,574.50.

Private senior transport van crashes in Maple Hts.

A passenger in a Provide-A-Ride senior transport medical van was injured and the van was heavily damaged when its driver failed to maintain control of the vehicle as it traveled south on Broadway Ave., in Maple Heights Monday morning and crashed into another vehicle and trees planted on the sidewalk in front of Music Manor, 15785 Broadway Ave.

Maple Heights Police Chief Todd Hansen said the initial investigation revealed the Provide-A-Ride van driver failed to maintain control of the vehicle, crossed the double yellow line into the oncoming lanes of travel, jumped the curb and struck a parked Chevy SUV and two of the trees that were planted on the sidewalk on the east side of Broadway, in front of Music Manor. The van stopped on top of one of the planters for the trees. The driver was given a citation for reasonable control.

There was one passenger in the Provide-A-Ride van who complained of back pain and was transported to the hospital for a medical evaluation, said Chief Hansen. The driver of the van stated he was not injured, and no one else was injured in this crash, Hansen said. The parked SUV received minor damage.

MHPD is still investigating the crash. Anyone with information is urged to call 216-662-1234.
