New councilmember chosen for Ward 5 in G.H.

Rachelle Tonsing was recently chosen by Garfield Heights City Council to replace Ward 5 Councilman Jason Blake, who was forced to resign his position last month after accepting a new job offer which would conflict with him being able to attend the necessary council meetings.

Tonsing was sworn in on July 7, in the office of Mayor Matthew Burke. She was not at Monday night's meeting of Garfield Heights Council, however, with her absence being excused.

The following legislation was passed by council Monday:

- Authorizing the city engineer to prepare the necessary plans and specifications and competitively bid for the Multi-Street Reconstruction & Waterline Replacement Project – Phase 7 – and authorizing payment of costs for the project.

- Submitting to the electorate an amendment to Section 12 of the city charter relating to qualifications for the president of council. If passed by voters at the Nov. 8, 2022 general election, "No councilmember shall be elected President of Council until that member has completed one full term of office. In the event no member of council has completed one full term of office at the time the president is elected, all members of council shall be eligible to be elected."

- Submitting to the electorate an amendment to Section 58 of the city charter regarding the time and method for submitting zoning changes to the electors.

If passed at the Nov. 8, 2022 election, "Notwithstanding anything in the charter or laws of this city to the contrary, any change to the existing land uses, or any legislation changing the existing zoning map, shall not become finally effective without approval of a majority of qualified electors of the city of Garfield Heights. Said issue shall be submitted to the electors of the city at the next primary or general election which shall occur not less than 60 days after its passage by council."

- Three separate ordinances amending collective bargaining agreements for jailers/records clerks, safety dispatchers and for police sergeants and above.

- Entering into an agreement with Monsido Inc. to ensure the city's website is compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

- Authorizing the mayor to execute a Roth 457 Option Employer Agreement with Ohio Public Employees Deferred Compensation to provide city employees with the opportunity to participate in a Roth 457.

Two dead in accident on Broadway at Aetna Rd.

Cleveland police report that a man and woman are dead after the motorcycle they were riding was hit by a speeding car on Broadway and Aetna Rd. in Slavic Village on Thursday, July 7, at about 2:40 a.m.

Dead is Bobby Henry, 22, of Maple Heights, driver of the motorcycle, and his passenger, Brianca Palmer, 32, of Buffalo, New York, according to local reports.

Police said a male operating a 2014 Mazda 6 was going west on Broadway Ave., well in excess of the speed limit, and appeared to be racing with a 2017 Honda Civic

operated by a female. The Mazda was driving left of center west in the eastbound lanes.

Henry was driving a 1998 Honda motorcycle with Palmer as a passenger. The motorcycle was eastbound on Broadway approaching the intersection at Aetna Rd. and was struck head-on by the Mazda.

The driver and a passenger in the Mazda fled the scene on foot. The driver of the Honda Civic failed to stop after the accident. A police investigation is ongoing.

Bedford Council OKs resident trash fee hike, puts proposed charter amendments on November ballot

Bedford Council approved legislation to raise trash collection costs for residents beginning with the real estate tax collection in 2023, and also passed several pieces of legislation for proposed charter amendments for voters to decide on the Tuesday, Nov. 8 ballot.

Residents currently pay \$14 per month, per unit, for garbage collection, recycling and disposal under the city's current contract with Kimble, and the fees have remained the same for the past several years. Under the new contract, also with Kimble, residents will pay \$18 per month, per unit, City Manager Mike Mallis stated, an increase of \$4 per month per unit. The changes take effect this month.

Proposed charter amendments

Council passed the following five ordinances for proposed charter changes, all recommended by the Charter Review Commission (CRC), to be considered by voters in the Tuesday, November 8 General Election:

- Equalizing population in the six wards of the city using federal census figures and making such boundary changes as they deem necessary or required, the legislation states. The population figures will only include adults over 18, or voting age.

- Amending qualifications of council members, to extend the six-month residency requirement to two years. In one of those two years, the candidate must be a resident of the ward for which he/she is seeking election.

- Amending announcement and filling of council vacancies to require that a council seat vacancy be announced in 10 days, that the vacancy be filled by an interim successor within 60 days, and that the election be held at the next regular or General Election, to be held 90 days after the determination of the vacancy, to allow candidates adequate time to circulate petitions.

- Amending notice of appropriation of property to change the number of readings from one to three before council authorizes the appropriation, and also to include electronic forms of notice to the owner, permitted by law.

- Changing the terms of the Civil Service Commission to four years to be consistent with other city board terms, and to allow the Finance Director (who also serves as the Secretary of the Civil Service Commission), to vote in case of a tie.

Three other ordinances to propose charter changes, all to conform with current law and the format approved by the State of Ohio, were defeated by council on the grounds that Ohio law already superseded them, and would take effect whether voters approved them or not.

Other items on agenda

Council approved the following ordinances at last week's meeting:

- Amending previous legislation to make additional budget appropriations for current expenditures of the city during 2022.

• A five-year contract with Julian & Grube, Inc., Certified Public Accountants, for the performance of city of Bedford independent audits for the years 2022 through 2026. The costs will increase incrementally each year, for a total cost of \$182,650 over the five-year term of the contract.

• Authorizing Mallis to accept the proposal of Gardiner for two rooftop compressors for the Municipal Complex, at a cost of \$12,988. Both existing compressors running the air conditioning units failed, requiring immediate replacement, Mallis said, adding that Gardiner would also provide a warranty on the equipment.

• Contracting with United Survey, Inc., to repair a failed storm sewer located at 671 Archer Rd., at a cost of \$12,075. United Survey will construct a "sleeve" around the failed section to restore sewer service, Mallis stated.

• Contracting with Angelo Benedetti, Inc., for asphalt surface recycling to repair sections of Button Rd. and Tudor Ave., at a cost of \$167,700. Mallis said that Benedetti is the sole source provider for the work, which uses the existing asphalt on the roadway and combines it with other materials, recycling it to create a new road surface.

Announcements

Mallis said the city was looking to resurface a portion of Turney Rd. in the next few years and confirmed that Bedford had received a \$250,000 Cuyahoga County grant towards that work. Because of the work expected to take place on Broadway next year, the city had applied for the Turney Rd. funding for 2023-24.

Elmer Flick, Bedford's own Baseball Hall of Famer, will be honored with Elmer Flick Days in the city this Friday, July 15, and Saturday, July 16, Mallis and Councilman Jeff Asbury stated. Events in the city will include screenings of the baseball-themed movies "The Sandlot" and "Field of Dreams." Visit museum@BedfordOhioHistory.org for details.

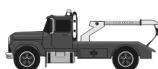
