## 3-year-old killed, 2 injured in hit-and-run accident

The Cleveland Division of Police Accident Investigation Unit is investigating a crash in which three bicyclists were struck and a three-year-old girl killed on Thursday, July 21, at approximately 10:08 p.m., in the North Broadway area of Cleveland.

Officers responded to Track Rd. and Lufkin Ave. for a crash involving bicyclists. On scene it was learned that all three bicyclists were operating southbound on Track Rd. in the traffic lane approaching Lufkin Ave. The suspect vehicle was operating northbound on Track Rd. from Lufkin Ave. The front end of the suspect vehicle collided with all three bicycles. The driver then fled the scene and has since been arrested and the suspect vehicle confiscated.

The victims, a 10-year-old girl, 27-year-old man and the 3-year-old girl were transported to UH Rainbow Babies and Children's Hospital, where the 3-year-old was pronounced deceased. The other two victims had minor injuries.

"I was deeply saddened to learn of this tragedy and offer my prayers and condolences to the family," said Mayor Justin Bibb. "This is the third child recently hit and killed by a car in the city of Cleveland. And once again the driver who committed this horrific crime fled the scene."

Members of the Accident Investigation Unit and the Third District Detective Bureau responded to the scene for investigation. The Real Time Crime Center is assisting with the investigation.

## Veterans' group honors fallen Garfield Hts. soldier

Last Sunday, July 24, Ride with Valor, a nonprofit group dedicated to helping US veterans as well as widows and widowers of veterans, held a Fallen Soldiers Memorial Torch Run through Garfield Heights, stopping at the York Blvd. home of Bob and Terri Davis, parents of the late US Army Cpl. Brad Davis.

Davis, 21, a 2006 graduate of Garfield Heights High School, died April 22, 2009, when a roadside bomb exploded near his vehicle in Baghdad, Iraq.

Ride with Valor hosted a ceremony at the Davis home to honor this American hero and fallen veteran. The ceremony included a procession of vehicles driving past the home.

Cpl. Davis is honored in his hometown as one-half of the namesake to the entrance to the Garfield Heights Civic Center complex, Davis-Benjamin Way.

## G.H. Council holds special meeting; safety meeting set

The following legislation was passed at a special meeting of Garfield Heights Council on Monday, July 25:

- Adopted the tax budget of the city for the fiscal year beginning Jan. 1, 2023, and submitting it to the Cuyahoga County Budget Commission.

- Repealed and replaced an amendment recently passed by council that provides for submission to voters of an amendment to the Garfield Heights Charter regarding the time and method for submitting zoning changes to the electors. The previous legislation passed said it must be submitted to the voters 60 days after passage by council. The new bill, upon the recommendation of the Cuyahoga County Board of Elections, says it must be submitted to voters 90 days after passage by council.

## Making of explosives likely cause of G.H. home explosion that killed three

Investigators with the Division of State Fire Marshal's Fire and Explosion Investigation Bureau (FEIB) in Ohio has determined that the probable cause of a home explosion that killed three people last month in Garfield Heights was the manufacturing of explosives.

On Saturday, June 12, Garfield Heights Fire responded to a home explosion at 4930 E. 81 St. in Garfield Heights. The bodies of three victims were recovered from the debris: 64-year-old Donald Malinowski, 57-year-old Gerald Bateman and 37-year-old Cassandra Bateman.

While conducting a joint scene exam with insurance company representatives on Friday, July 8, Garfield Heights firefighters located the remnants of cardboard tubes, consistent with the manufacturing of explosive devices, in the basement of the home.

On Monday, July 11, FEIB investigators returned to the scene where they found more than 30 cardboard tubes of varying sizes, along with fuses, equipment and chemicals associated with the manufacturing of explosives.

State Fire Marshal Forensic Lab Bureau Chief Chad Wissinger said, "The materials recovered from the scene are used in the manufacturing of M-series type explosive devices, which contain higher amounts of explosive powders than what is typically found in consumer-grade fireworks."

Fire investigators say the official cause will remain undetermined pending the final report from the Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner, but the most probable cause is the manufacturing of explosives.

"Dominion Energy ran numerous tests and didn't find any evidence of a gas leak anywhere on the property. Additionally, the Ohio EPA tested the ground for migrating methane gas and found nothing of note," FEIB Assistant Chief Ray McCarthy, said. "This information, combined with evidence found at the scene and witness testimony, leads us to believe manufacturing of explosives is the cause of this explosion."

### Felonious Assault

On July 10, at 5:22 p.m., units responded to the area of E. 86 St. and Garfield Blvd. for a report of numerous

females fighting with knives. Police saw two females on the east side of the street. Dispatch advised there was a stabbing victim at a home in the 4700 block of E. 86 St. Officers on scene detained the two females and went to assist the stabbing victim, who had a large cut on the side of her left thigh. She said one of the girls who had stabbed here was one of the females officers had detained. A witness said that two of the females had been arguing and fighting and the victim ran over with a stun gun-type weapon and attempted to zap one of the females, who then got up and stabbed the victim. Police located a knife in a neighboring yard. The suspect was arrested and taken to city jail. She had sustained numerous cuts and scrapes from the fight and was seen by a squad but refused any medical attention. She was held on no bond on two counts of felonious assault.

### Theft of Motor Vehicle

On July 10, at about 5:40 a.m., an officer was dispatched to the GHPD lobby to take a motorcycle theft report. The

owner said his Harley Davidson motorcycle was taken from his detached garage at some point during the evening. He received a phone call from Cleveland police who told him his motorcycle had been involved in an accident in their jurisdiction. He then checked his garage and saw his motorcycle had been stolen without keys. It was towed by CPD to a lot on Quigley Ave.

### Menacing

On July 11, at about 8:25 p.m., an officer was called to the GHPD lobby to take a report of a man threatening a woman in traffic. The woman said she was driving her car northwest bound on Broadway Ave., from E. 131 St., when a white Ford E-250 began to enter her lane and she used her horn to alert him when his vehicle almost hit her's. Both vehicles were at a traffic light at Broadway and Henry St., when the male driver yelled out, "Do you know who I am?" He then brandished a pistol but never pointed it at her. 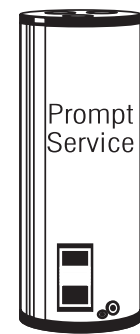
