Meeting set on rebuilding of Garfield Boulevard

A meeting will be held on Wednesday, March 23, at 6 p.m., in Garfield Heights Council Chambers, 5407 Turney Rd., for residents and stakeholders to share their thoughts about a new vision for the rebuilding of the Garfield Blvd. Corridor.

The city of Garfield Heights and its regional partners are undertaking a project to rebuild Garfield Blvd. and include a new trail along the corridor which will connect Garfield Park Reservation and the Towpath Trail. It seeks to also improve pedestrian safety and help reestablish the neighborhood business district.

I-77N closure tomorrow

I-77 north to I-480 eastbound will be closed beginning Thursday, March 17, at 8 p.m. through Friday, March 18, at 5 a.m. for bridge work in connection with the Brecksville Rd. bridge rehabilitation over I-480 in the city of Independence, ODOT reports.

Detour will be I-77 northbound to I-480 westbound to Granger Rd. to I-480 eastbound.

The I-480 Project, which involves pavement replacement and ramp realignment, will close I-480 westbound to SR 176 northbound at 9 p.m. Monday, March 21, through 5 a.m. Tuesday, March 22, for pavement work.

Detour will be Granger Rd. west to Tuxedo Ave. north to Industrial Pkwy. north to Spring Rd. west to SR 176.

Schools superintendent in Garfield Heights resigns

The resignation of Garfield Heights Schools Superintendent Chris Hanke was accepted at a special meeting of the Garfield Heights Board of Education on Feb. 28, Hanke told The Neighborhood News.

Hanke said his resignation will be effective July 31, 2022, to give the board plenty of time to find a replacement. He said he was "looking at other opportunities" and it seemed like the right time to move on.

An email to Garfield Heights School Board President Nichelle Daniels seeking comment last week was not returned as of press time yesterday.

Hens ordinance passed to third reading in Garfield

Garfield Heights Council met Monday night and passed for a third reading legislation to allow residents to keep female chickens, aka hens, in the city. A codified ordinance now on the books prohibits them.

The proposed amended ordinance stipulates that hens may be kept only in a U1 Residential Single-Family or U2 Residential Single- and Two-Family District. Before the keeping of hens can occur, according to the legislation, an annual permit must first have been obtained from the building department for a \$25 fee paid to the city. Several other restrictions regarding setbacks, enclosures, inspections, sanitation, etc., are included in the ordinance.

An added restriction on the keeping of hens in the city was passed at Monday's meeting to include in the amended legislation that property owners on either side of those wishing to keep hens must give their written permission for this to occur.

It will go before council a third time for final passage. Also passed were the following pieces of legislation:

- •Increasing the uniform allowance of the Garfield Heights Auxiliary Police Force from \$250 to \$500 per year. The auxiliary has not received a uniform allowance increase since 2006.
- \bullet Purchasing 15 Motorola portable radios for the police department.
- Placing a temporary moratorium, not to exceed six months, on carwash establishments within the city.
- Making additional appropriations for current expenditures during the fiscal year ending Dec. 31, 2022.
- •Amending the purchase of four 2022 Ford Police Explorers from Montrose Ford at a total cost of \$155,530.
- Purchasing three 2022 Ford Explorers from Montrose Ford at a total cost of \$100,500.
- •Appointing Jennifer Sopkovich to serve as director of the Garfield Heights Community Diversion Program retroactive from Feb. 21, 2022, to Dec. 31, 2023. Councilman Jason Seither abstained from the voting as Sopkovich is his sister.
- Providing for only one council meeting to be held on the second Monday in the months of June, July and August.

Referred to the Ways & Means Committee of council was an ordinance to make adjustments to the city's wards so that the population of the respective wards is as nearly equal in population as is possible as provided by the 2020 Census data.

The next regular meeting of council will be held Monday, March 28.

License plate reading cameras coming to C.H.

At its regular meeting on Wednesday, March 9, Cuyahoga Heights Council passed a resolution that will allow Flock Group, Inc. to provide license plate reading cameras for the police department for a period of two years.

The Cuyahoga Heights police chief obtained a proposal from Flock Safety to provide 14 cameras to the village at a cost of \$2,500 per camera and one-time implementation fee of \$250 per camaera for a total cost of \$38,500 for the first year and \$35,000 for the second year.

Information collected can be used by police to find out where a plate has been in the past, determine whether a vehicle was at the scene of a crime, identify travel patterns and more, according to information on the Electronic Frontier Foundation website. The data, which includes photographs of the vehicle and sometimes its driver and passengers, is then uploaded to a central server.

Other legislation passed included:

- •Entering into a lease-to-own agreement with First Capital Equipment Leasing Corp. for three new 2022 Ford F-250 regular cab 4x4 pickup trucks for the service department;
- Resolution recognizing and affirming support for Ukrainian sovereignty and firmly stating that the Village of Cuyahoga Heights stands on the side of freedom and individual self-determination and self-governance.

Purchases approved were: three new tasers not to exceed \$7,800, a Meritech copy machine for the police department not to exceed \$7,800, and seven ballastic vests from Pro-Tech not to exceed \$7,000.




