On Feb. 18, 2023, Reginald "Reggie" McDuffie, Jr. was shot and killed while standing in the front yard of a residence talking with friends in the 4500 block of E. 126 St., in Garfield Heights. No arrests have been made in his murder.

Maple Hts. police seek information on shooting last week near high school

Last Wednesday afternoon, a teenage boy suffered non-life threatening injuries when he was shot in the area of Clement Ave. and Mapleboro Rd., near Maple Heights High.

On March 8, around 3:20 p.m., the Maple Heights Police Department responded to the area of Clement and Mapleboro for a report of several gunshots in the area. Maple Heights High School was placed on lockdown as a precaution while police investigated.

A 17-year-old male juvenile was located a short while later with a gunshot wound to his left hip. He was transported to MetroHealth Medical Center with non-life threatening injuries. MHPD were able to determine that the high school was in no danger and the lockdown was lifted at 4:10 p.m.

Free smoke detectors Marshals arrest G.H. homicide suspect

Mayor Matt Burke, a Monday night's council meeting, announced that the Garfield Heights Fire Department has obtained over 6000 smoke detectors that are being made available free of charge to residents.

Last Thursday members of the Northern Ohio Violent Fugitive Task Force (NOVTF) located and arrested Travis Hicks, 32, U.S. Marshals have announced. Hicks was wanted by the Garfield Heights Police Department for murder.

It is alleged that on Sept. 25, 2022, Hicks shot and killed Ronnie Briggs, 27, at the Showcase Bar and Grill in Garfield Heights. Briggs was the co-owner of the bar, and the shooting followed an argument that took place between Briggs and Hicks, U.S. Marshals said in a press release. Hicks has been on the run ever since, and last week members of the task force arrested Hicks at an apartment near 1900 block of Ford Dr., Cleveland.

"Our fugitive task force will continue to take dangerous fugitives off the streets in northern Ohio," said U.S. Marshal Pete Elliott. "The men and women of our task force pour their hearts into these cases and don't rest until these fugitives are brought to justice."

Holy Spirit Hunger Center director honored for 30 years of service at Garfield Hts. Council meeting

Garfield Heights Council met Monday night and passed a resolution honoring Eva Curry Traylor for serving the Garfield Heights community for 30 years and counting as director of what is now the Holy Spirit Hunger Center on E. 131 St.

The resolution notes that Eva is helped by Holy Spirit Pastor David Nestler at the hunger center, along with her family which includes 12 grandchildren, volunteers from the community and the Holy Spirit Catholic Church community.

"I couldn't do it without Fr. David," Eva said as she accepted her resolution at the meeting, surrounded by family, friends and, of course, Fr. David.

At Monday night's meeting council also passed the following:

- On its third reading, council passed an ordinance to fix the salary of the mayor at \$100,000 per year, effective Dec. 1, 2025, after the Nov. 2025 mayoral election. The salary of the mayor was cut to \$85,000 per year in 2009, during the city's fiscal crisis, and hasn't been raised since, city leaders have stated.

- Entering into a contract with Brite for the purchase of a body worn camera system including all requisite software and maintenance. The agreement will include the purchase and five-year warranty of approximately 45 body-worn cameras, charging stations and all requisite accessories as well as one year of cloud storage for the body-worn camera footage.

The city of Garfield Heights was granted a total of \$74,357 from the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services for the purchase of the cameras, so the total cost to the city for the 45 cameras will not exceed \$10,000.

- Purchasing one 2023 Chevrolet Tahoe from Ganley Chevrolet of Aurora, at a cost not to exceed \$43,645.

- Entering into an agreement with Carrier Commercial Service for the purchase, installation and maintenance of

two air conditioning units for the Garfield Heights Civic Center, at a cost not to exceed \$90,000.

- Accepting the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council Energized Community Grant of \$57,952 for 2023.

- Applying for a Training and Equipment Grant provided by the Ohio Department of Public Safety - Division of Emergency Medical Services, for the city's fire department.

EMS Hit Skipped

On March 7, at 10:27 p.m., an EMS unit was involved in a hit/skip at E. 55th and Broadway, with minor damage to the EMS vehicle and no injuries.

Felonious Assault

On March 11, about 1 a.m., University Hospitals advised GHPD that it had a female in trauma with a gunshot wound. A patrolman was sent to the hospital and later found 7 shell casings in front of the Sherwin Williams store. The report was withheld pending further investigation.

Traffic Offense – Fleeing

On March 6, at about 3:45 a.m., a patrol officer observed a silver Lexus going west on McCracken Rd. at Turney Rd., with no visible license plate and heavily tinted windows. The officer initiated a traffic stop and when he got out of his patrol car, the Lexus took off, going up to 60 mph in residential areas and ignoring stop signs. Once the Lexus passed Plymouth Ave., northbound on E. 88 St., the driver lost control of the car, striking a utility pole on the east side of the road splintering it into several pieces. It then crossed over E. 88 St., where it struck a tree and came to a stop. The driver did not respond to verbal commands, and GHFD was dispatched to treat her as she was in and out of consciousness. The driver was taken to Marymount Hospital and cited for display of plates, fleeing and eluding, operation in willful or wanton disregard, driving under suspension and expired plates.

Animal Cruelty

On March 6, an officer spoke with the Garfield Heights animal warden who said he received a call on March 4, about 2:40 p.m., from a woman living in the 13800 block of Cranwood Dr. who said she found a dead dog in her backyard. The animal warden said he responded to the address and found the pit bull mix dog dead with a bullet hole on its right hip area. Information from the dog's tag led police to its owner, a Cleveland woman, who said her

dog had run off. Animal warden is unsure who shot the dog. The report will be forwarded to him for followup and charges.

Disorderly Conduct

On March 9, about 12:45 a.m., police were dispatched to Bonker's bar, 5147 Turney Rd., for two females arguing inside with the bartender. When they arrived they found a white female and black female yelling at each other and then at the officers outside the bar. The white female was asked for ID, which she at first refused to give, saying she was pregnant so she couldn't go to jail. She eventually provided her ID. Both women were yelling and cursing at officers, who told them to leave the area. Due to all the commotion, people from inside the bar came out to see what was going on. The white female said in front of officers that she was going to "shoot up the place" and made several gestures with her hands shooting her finger guns at officers and the bar. She was arrested and placed in handcuffs in front of her body as she was about five months pregnant. The black female still on scene in front of Bonkers started to yell about her lawyer and refusing to leave the area, saying she wanted to go with her baby mama (the white female in custody). After given several chances to leave and still causing undue noise and commotion outside Bonkers, she was also placed under arrest for disorderly conduct.

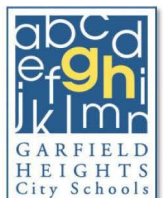
