Owners of apartment complexes in the city of Bedford will now have to install video surveillance systems at their properties and share the video with the Bedford police upon request, after council approved an ordinance enacting the new chapter of the city's business regulation and building code at its meeting Monday night.

The legislation states that "with an increase in crimes and vehicle thefts, security and surveillance cameras would be helpful in preventing and solving crimes." The cameras will be required to be installed at building entrances and exits of complexes comprised of 10 or more individual rental units, as well as in the parking lots and parking garages.

Property owners who do not install the cameras within six months of passage of the legislation will receive a notice of violation, and if the violation continues after 30 days of the first notice and proof of compliance is not provided, a \$500 fine will be imposed.

There is a provision for exemptions through the police department, if the apartment complex "has or will undertake alternate security procedures which are substantially equal to or more effective in preventing criminal activity and in assisting in the apprehension of the perpetrators of crime," the ordinance states.

City Manager Mike Mallis confirmed that the ordinance would require apartment complexes to provide video security surveillance on the exterior of the property but not inside.

Also passed at the meeting was an ordinance allowing city of Bedford employees to make insurance plan premium contributions on a pretax basis for next year through Health Equity/Wage Works.

Placed on second reading was a resolution for the city to enter into a two-year contract with the Health District of Cuyahoga County for health services for the years 2024 and 2025.

The cost of the services to Bedford is \$95,330 for 2024, and \$105,192 for 2025. Council will discuss the legislation further before passage at a future meeting.

Student shot outside Cleveland Central Catholic

A 15-year-old boy was shot Friday afternoon outside Cleveland Central Catholic High School on Baxter Ave., Cleveland, following an altercation after school was dismissed, as reported by various media outlets. The victim was taken to the hospital and his condition has not been disclosed.

As a result, classes were canceled Monday "out of an abundance of caution," and this Saturday's homecoming game has been moved to another venue with no spectators allowed. The homecoming dance has been postponed to a later date. Cleveland police continue to investigate.

Simon's opening Saturday

Mayor Stan Koci announced at the meeting that the new Simon's Supermarket will be opening in Bedford, in the Meadowbrook Shopping Center at Rockside and Northfield rds., at 8 a.m. this Saturday, Oct. 21.

Koci said that Saturday's opening will be a "soft opening," and a grand opening will be held in the next two to three weeks.

Another meeting of the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency's Transportation for Livable Communities Initiative (TLCI) will be held on Wednesday, Nov. 29, at 6 p.m. at Ellenwood Recreation Center, Mallis said. A plan on the TLCI project, which is intended to connect the Metroparks Bedford Reservation with the Historic Downtown District and other areas of the city, will be presented in early 2024, with eligibility for grant funding to follow, he said.

Young organist phenom to perform at St. Stanislaus

Seventeen-year-old classical organ prodigy Daniel Colaner, who overcame stage IV cancer as an infant partly through exposure to music as cognitive therapy, will perform a concert on the recently restored Wm. Schuelke organ at the historic Shrine Church of St. Stanislaus, 3649 E. 65 St., in Slavic Village, this Sunday, Oct. 22, at 4 p.m. The concert will include pieces by European, African American and female composers.

Colaner is a resident of Akron and a member of St. Sébastien Parish. His passion for the keyboard began on the piano at age five and on the organ at age ten. He first caught the attention of organ enthusiasts during his same-day performances at New York City's Carnegie Hall and St. Patrick's Cathedral. Since then his talents have been showcased on ABC's World News Tonight and Good Morning America, the Harry Connick Show and the BBC.

As the recipient of the Anthony Quinn Foundation scholarship, Colaner got the opportunity this summer to play on some of the great church organs in Paris, France, including at the Church of St. Sulpice and the royal chapel of the Palace of Versailles.

He is currently the organ scholar at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Cleveland Heights and a private organ student of David Higgs of the Eastman School of Music.

Admission to Sunday's concert is free and sponsored by the Slavic Village Historical Society in cooperation with St. Stanislaus.

Garfield Hts. Council news

The following legislation was passed by Garfield Heights Council at its Oct. 11 meeting:

- Authorizing the sale and disposal of city-owned property no longer needed.
- Applying for Community Development Block Grant funds and entering into an agreement with the Cuyahoga County Department of Development to improve the parking area,

sidewalks and entrance to the Civic Center.

- Applying for Community Development Supplemental Grant funds and entering into an agreement with the Cuyahoga County Department of Development for improvements at the Civic Center. The city is eligible to receive up to \$50,000 from the county's Casino Tax Revenue Funds.
- Amending part of the

Building Code of the codified ordinances of the city to increase building permit fees.

- Renewing an agreement with the Cuyahoga County Juvenile Court to continue participation in the Cuyahoga County Community Diversion Program.

- Entering into a contract with the Cuyahoga County General Health District to provide health services to the city for the years 2024-25, at a total cost of \$454,160.

- Recognizing Robert Burge for his outstanding service to the community.

Mr. Burge served as a priest from 1971 to 2001. He moved to Jennings on Granger Rd., in Garfield Heights, in 2011 and got permission from Mayor Vic Collova to plant flowers on the tree lawn at Jennings, a beautiful display that he grows and cultivates each year. He also painted all the fire hydrants in front of Jennings, receiving a commendation for this from the

Garfield Heights Fire Department.

- Appointing Jennifer Sopkovich to continue to serve as the director of the Garfield Heights Commu-

nity Diversion Program from Jan. 1, 2024 to Dec. 31, 2024.
